Diversion of 0.1129 hac Govt./ Forest land for the construction of Swerage Treatment Plant at Shah Talai. Tehsil Jhandutta- District. Bilaspur, H.P. in the state of H.P.

A proposal has been received by this office from Executive Engineer, Ghumarwin Division I&PH Distt. Bilaspur, H.P. for diversion (Under FCA1980) of 0.1129 hac. of forest land for Non forestry purpose. The project envisages the use of forest land for the construction of Swerage Treatment Plant at village Shah Talai. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on dated 29-01-2016

On inspection of the site, It is found that the land required by the user agency is a (Charand Jungle Dehati) UPF forest measuring 0.5712 hac.

The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in column No. 2 of part- I is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.- Yes.
