3.0 The project has been initiated by Reliance JIO Infocomm Ltd., for seeking approval under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for laying underground Optical Fiber Cable line from Yavatmal to Ner Road SH No.300 from Km 130/00 to Km 144/400 passing through forest area in Compartment No.513,511,504,502,307,308 of village Bhosa, Bothgavan, Pandhari, Rahuldari, Kolambi in Yavatmal Forest Division. The aforesaid project is pursuant to the directives issued by the Government of India, Ministry of Communication & IT Department of Telecommunication vide their letter No. 222/2008,dt.19/09/2008. The User Agency has highlighted that as per the

policy of the Government of India, it is planned to lay Optical Fiber Cable for reliable communication from remote place to District/State Headquarters. Basic aim of the project is to provide the people of under developed areas with reliable and high speed media connectivity. In this regard, the User Agency has submitted the proposal for diversion 0.23 ha forest land under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. The site inspection report of the Deputy Conservator of Forests, Yavatmal Forest Division, Yavatmal is enclosed on page no. 29 to 30.

4.00 The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Yavatmal Forest Division, Yavatmal has certified that:-

- 4.1 no suitable alternate land is available and the forest land required is minimum.
- 4.2 the area belongs to Eco-value class-III and having density is 0.4 to 0.6 (Tropical Dry Deciduous Forest)
- 4.3 there is no cutting and felling of trees involved in this project
- 4.4 the area involved in the project does not form part of any existing National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Nature Reserve etc.
- 4.5 proposed project is not likely to affect any monumental site of cultural, historical, religious, archeological or recreational importance.
- 4.6 there is no violation of Forest (Conservation) Act 1980.
- 4.7 the proposed area for the project is beyond 45.00 km from the boundary of the protected area (Sanctuary and National Park).
- the non-forest area covered under the project is not under the provision of Maharashtra Private Forest (Acquisition) Act 1975 by virtue of application of Section 35 of Indian Forest Act 1927 and are not recognized as deemed reserved forest as well as not included in the area identified as "forest" as per dictionary meaning of forest as intimated to the expert committee appointed under interim judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 12/12/1996.

5.00 The User Agency has submitted an undertaking that:-

- 5.1 to defray the cost of compensatory afforestation.
- 5.2 to defray the cost of Net Present Value of the forest land proposed under diversion.
- 5.3 the alignment of the trench shall be varied shall ensure no damage and safety of existing tree growth.
- the project is in ROW alongwith the State Highway, hence settlement of rights in accordance with Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 is not required.
- 5.5 The Government of India has conveyed its general approval under the Section-2(ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 vide Chapter 4 of comprehensive guidelines issued vide letter No.5-2/2017-FC, dt. 28/3/2019 for 15 activities for diversion not more than 1.00 ha forest land to Government Departments, Government undertakings, Boards, Corporations

The proposed Optical Cable line from Yavatmal to Fata Ghatanji Road SH 300 from Km.130/00 to Km 144/400 is passing through forest area in Compartment No.513,511,504,502,307,308 of village Bhosa, Bothagavan, Pandhari,Rahuldari, Kolambi in Yavatmal Forest Division of the Maharashtra State.

- 5.4 The copy of the administrative approval accorded by the Government of Maharashtra, PWD, Yavatmal Public Works Department vide letter No.07/01/2021 is enclosed on page no.51
- 5.5 The copy of the cross section map is enclosed on page no.16
- 5.6 The forest land comprising of 0.008 ha in the proposal in Compartment no.511 belongs to FDCM Ltd. The user agency has submitted NOC accorded by the Divisional Manager, Forest Project Divisional, Yavatmal vide letter No. FPD/DM/YTL/Plan/930, dated 05/07/2018 copy enclosed on page no.54.
- 6.00 In view of this, the proposal is recommended for approval under the section -2 (ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 subject to the following conditions: –
- i) The legal status of the land shall remain unchanged.
- ii) As per Government of India guidelines No.FC-11/165/2019, FC dt.27/7/2020 the compensatory afforesation may not be levied in case of laying of underground Optical Fiber Cables(OFC). Therefore the cost of compensatory afforesation may not be insist upon the User Agency.
- iii) Net Present Value is exempted for laying of underground Optical Fiber Cable as per the Government of India guidelines.
- iv) The Optical Fiber Cable Line will be laid within maximum size of the trench of 2.00 m depth & 1.0 m width with cable line under the PVC Pipeline.
- v) The land under project will be reclaimed by the user agency for which the agency shall submit a bank guarantee at the rate of Rs. 50/- per running meter and an undertaking to that effect shall also be submitted. If the agency fails to reclaim the land to the satisfaction of Deputy Conservator of Forests concerned, the cost for reclamation will be recovered from the bank guarantee.
- vi) If the cable is going to be laid in the formation width of the road, then additional charges in form of bank guarantee shall be given at the rate of Rs.35/- per running mtr. Similarly for reclamation of side drain and for tarred portion, the guarantee will be at the rate of Rs. 300/- per mtr. and Rs.750/- per mtr. respectively. An undertaking shall be obtained from the user agency that it has agreed to make good any loss to Forest/ Environment while laying the cable in the forest area and during maintenance of the same in future. For further maintenance of the project, the agency shall obtain permission from the Forest Department as and when required.
- vii) The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than specified in the proposal.

- viii) No felling of trees shall done during the implementation of project.
- ix) The user agency will be authorized to lay the Optical Fiber Cable outside the confines of the protected area after compliance of this order. Any breach of the conditions by the user agency will be treated as violation of the provision of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.
- x) No new forest area beyond the Right of Way of existing road should be broken for laying Optical Fiber Cable.
- xi) No labour camps shall be established on the forest land.
- xii) The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of the Central Government.
- xiii) The sanction will be subject to final clearance as per the directives issued by the Government of India, Ministry of Communication & IT Department of Telecommunication vide their letter No. 222/2008,dt.19/09/2008 and concerned PWD authorities of the project.
- xiv) The User Agency will be authorized to lay the Optical Cable only outside the confines of the Protected Area. Any breach of the said condition by the User Agency will be treated as violation of the provisions of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.
- xv) All the conditions stipulated by the Forest Department shall be binding on the User Agency.
- xvi) All other conditions as may be mandatory under relevant Act, Rules and Guidelines shall be compiled with by the User Agency.
- xvii) All necessary approvals required for the project as per the prevailing laws of the land would be obtained by the User Agency before statutory sanctions.

xviii) The User Agency will make good the land after use/maintenance.
