Site Inspection Report:

The proposed diversion sites for laying of Transmission Line in different areas in the mouzas of Balarambati, Barachatra, Ramharipur, Bhatkunda under Panagarh & Guskara Range of Burdwan Division involved in the Forest Land of 2.131 Ha. The sites were inspected on 19.08.2021.

- i) Classification of the forest is notified as "Protected Forest".
- ii) The proposed area is minimum forest area required for the project which as per their plan can not be done away with.
- iii) There is no requirement of felling of trees in the forest only minor lopping of 14 nos. trees. No felling of trees is required for the project.
- iv) Care should be taken of the fact that the area may experience elephant passage at any time in future. Strict maintenance should be done to prevent downward sagging of the overhead transmission line.
- Necessary measures are required to be taken for protection and maintenance of such fragmented pieces of forest land.
 Hence, the proposal is recommended subject to review at higher level and fulfillment of other criterias as per Act & Rule.
