SITE INSPECTION REPORT

The Site Inspection for the proposal for **Bhairab Hill Stone Quarry** for the purpose of Mining for Extraction of Stone/Boulders for use/suply in developmental activities under Bongaigaon and adjoining districts by the Divisional Forest Officer, Aie Valley Division, Bongaigaon in Bhairab PRF under Aie Valley Forest Division was carried out by the undersigned on 08.12.2018. During the inspection, it was found that the Forest Land required by the User Agency is 5.00 Ha. The proposed Mining for Extraction of Stone/Boulders for use/suply in developmental activities under Bongaigaon and adjoining districts is selected on the Proposed Reserve Forest where the density of the Forest is nil and thereby requiring minimal or no felling of trees and disturbance to the Wildlife will be nil. The requirement of the Forest land is unavoidable and barest minimum for the Project. The area proposed for diversion does not form part of any Wildlife Sanctuary. The area has no importance from protected archaeological point of view and there is no heritage site/ defence establishment or any other important monument along the area proposed for Diversion.
