**SPECIFIC RECOMMENDATION OF CONSERVATOR OF EASTERN ASSAM CIRCLE,
JORHAT FOR ACCEPTANCE**

The proposed diversion of Forest Land for Madhupur Gravel Mahal inside Rengma Reserve Forest is under Uriamghat Range of Golaghat Division.

The Golaghat district with an area of 3500 km² and population of 10,66,888; is lagging behind in infrastructure development. There is a huge shortage of gravel and sand gravel in Golaghat & adjoining district. So, to meet the immediate requirement of gravel for development works a new Mahal needs to be immediately opened. The requisition of forest land is unavoidable as the gravel is available in the entire district in Reserve Forest area only.

The proposal for diversion of forest land measuring 5.0 hectare of each mahal inside Rengma Reserve Forest for Madhupur Gravel Mahal is hereby recommended at the site proposed for diversion by the User agency
