

Field Inspection Note of Sri. Ch. Ganga Reddy, S.F.S., District Forest Officer, Mahabubnagar on 21/07/2018 at Jamalpur Forest Block in Compt. No. 319 & Mahabubnagar Forest Block in Compt. No. 328, 337 & 338 of Koilkonda & Mahabubnagar Sections of Mahabubnagar Range of Mahabubnagar District.

On 21/07/2018 proceeded and inspected the area proposed for diversion of **0.0157 Ha** of Forest-Land in **Compt. No. 319** of **Jamalpur Forest Block** area of Koilkonda Section and **0.1149 Ha** of Forest land in **Compt. No. 328, 337 & 338** of **Mahabubnagar Forest Block** of Mahabubnagar Range, Mahabubnagar Forest Division for **laying of Optical Fibre Cable along the road** and within the existing Right of way in favour of **M/s. Reliance Jio Infocomm Ltd.**, is transacted and observed that:

The total Forest Area in **Compt. No. 319** of **Jamalpur Reserve Forest** is **234.310 Ha**, **Compt. No. 328** of **Mahabubnagar Reserve Forest** is **218.530 Ha**, **Compt. No. 337** of **Mahabubnagar Reserve Forest** is **178.060 Ha**, & **Compt. No. 338** of **Mahabubnagar Reserve Forest** is **246.850 Ha**. The Forest Area of this Compartments Area is degraded area and having only bushy and miscellaneous growth. The canopy density is about **0.20**. There are no Trees falling in the proposed area for **laying of Optical Fibre Cable along the road** and within the existing Right of way, in the proposed areas of Jamalpur & Mahabubnagar Reserve Forests. There are no rare / endangered / unique species of flora and fauna in this proposed area and also there are no protected archaeological / heritage site/defence establishment.

The degraded Forest area diverted for this purpose is only **0.1306 Ha**. The area proposed for **laying of Optical Fibre Cable along the road** Passing through the Koilkonda & Mahabubnagar sections of Reserve Forest Blocks Jamalpur & Mahabubnagar in Mahabubnagar Range of Mahabubnagar District, in favour of **M/s. Reliance Jio Infocomm Ltd.**, also provides internet connectivity from Villages to Mandals, and Mandals to District Head Quarters.

There are no rare / endangered / unique species of flora and fauna in this proposed area and also there are no protected archaeological / heritage site/defence establishment. Etc.,

Hence, it is recommended to divert the Forest Area.
