The proposal is recommended, as the GHMC is scientifically treating and disposing about 5800 Mt (on an average) Municipal Solid Waste generated in the city at Integrated Municipal Solid Waste Management (IMSW) plant located at Jawahar Ngar. <p>As such the working load on this existing IMSW facility is exceed beyond the original plan in the original DPR. Therefore, the GHMC is bound to develop T&D facility in other directions to the city.</p> <p>The Hon'ble National Green Tribunal, New Delhi has also issued directions in O.A.No.780/2017, Dated. 17.12.2017 to the State of Telangana to identify land fill sites in the State within three months of orders and ensure that Solid Waste is disposed in such site strictly accordingly to the Solid Waste Management Rule, 2016.</p>

	<p>In this process, GHMC has acquired land to an extent of 152 Ac area located at Pyaranagar (V) Gummadidala (M) from Revenue Department for the purpose of establishment (MSW) treatment. but the land is not having proper approach road.</p> <p>Therefore, to avoid the plying the vehicle carrying MSW from the surrounding village roads and to have a direct approach to the said site from the nearest main road i.e., State Highways SH6, GHMC was finalized the approach road alignment through forest land after the joint inspected by the GHMC and Revenue Department Officials along with the Concessionaire for the proposed MSW Plant and the details of Forest land required.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 2. It is recommended to erect chainlink fencing both the sides of the Reserve Forest; to avoid any trespassing into RF; at the cost of user agency. 3. The Forest land diversion as proposed by the User Agency is unavoidable and barest minimum for the project. Hence the proposals for forest land diversion to an extent of 0.6228 Ha, are recommended, for Laying approach road to the proposed Municipal Solid Waste (MSW) treatment and disposal facility at Pyaranagar by GHMC through Nallavally RF.
