Site Visit: - The applied area proposed for diversion lies in 18.3205 ha of notified forest land and 10.1636 ha of deemed forest area. The proposed North Karnpura transmission line to Chandwa passes through Ara, Chamatu, Phulbasiya Amarwadih, Chetar, Seregara, Nagara, Pundurlawa, Jarri, Basiya, Gerenja, Jogiadih, Semarsot, Hempur, Murgaon, Chitarpur, Nagar, Chatro, Angara, Ambadohar villages of Latehar Forest Division. The density of the vegetation is 0.5 and site quality III.
