

## SITE INSPECTION REPORT NOT BELOW THE RANK OF DCF

(For the forest land to be diverted under FCA)

A proposal has been received by p.w.d. Agra for diversion (under FCA - 1980) of **2.45 hectares** of Protected Forest land for non-forestry purpose. the project envisages the use of forest land for "Six Lane Road Widening from Avantibai Chauraha to Raohata Canal Road ( City part of Agra-Gwalior Road ) , in District Agra.

The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on dated 30.05.2017

On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a Protected Forest (PF) measuring **2.45 hectares**

The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in Col.2 of part -1 is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.
