

The User agency shall raise strip plantation on both sides and central verge of the road as per the IRC norms.</li> <li>3. Adequate number of ramblers / speed breakers and underground/ over passages shall be provided to facilitate movement of wildlife and to avoid accidents as recommended by CWLW/ NBWL/FAC/REC.</li> <li>4. Display board at starting and ending point showing details of forest land involved in diversion and clearly mentioning the status of land as 'Forest land'.</li> <li>5. Suitable protection structures shall be included in the proposed road having steep gradient to avoid soil erosion.</li> <li>6. All DGPS surveyed points shall be clearly demarcated on the field and proposed alignment shall be followed.</li> <li>7. The User agency shall obtain Environmental Clearance as per the provisions of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986, if applicable.</li> <li>8.
