

Site Inspection Report of D.C.F.

- 1- The Part of Proposed Storm Water Drainage Project Site is Protected Forest (Road Side P.F.)
- 2- No any rare / endangered / unique species of flora and fauna are found in that area.
- 3- No any Protected Archeological / Heritage site / Defense establishment or any other important monument is located in that area.
- 4- Actual requirement of Forest Land is approx. 0.09 Ha.
- 5- No any work in violation of the F.C. Act has been reported till date.
- 6- GPS Readings are as follows.

1. Gauravgarh to Lohianagar Chauk -

26°07'32.58" N, 86°36'44.97" E.

26°07'22.14" N, 86°36'11.89" E.

2- Lohianagar Chauk to Degree College Chauk -

26°07'22.14" N, 86°36'11.88" E,

26°07'41.20" N, 86°36'32.17" E.

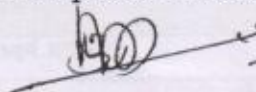
- 7- This Storm water Drainage project site will help the people surrounding and passing through NH-327E and 327 A. Part of it is other Govt. land.
- 8- List of trees to be felled / shifted is enclosed herewith.
- 9- Area wise description -

1- Gauravgarh chauk to Lohianagar chauk is part of Saharsa - Bangaon - Supaul - Pipra roadside P.F. As per list prepared jointly 18 no. of trees to be felled and 159 no. of ^{plants (not trees)} ~~trees~~ to be shifted including other Govt. land. We discussed this matter with Executive Engineer BUDCO as changing alignment or direction to approx. 2ft. will save almost all trees felled. But he refused to change alignment saying not feasible due to storm water drainage system.

2- I.T.I. College road is not protected forest but other Govt. land applicable and accordingly need to be shifted.

3- In B.S.S. College campus we have planted plants under Har Parisar Hara Parisar as SMRITI VATIKA. Almost all the important person took part in planting tree in her father /mother /grandparent name including local M.L.A., M.P., State Minister, D.M., S.P. & others. Here too, being the Govt. college, Plants needs to be shifted.

4- Lohianagar Chauk to Degree College chauk comes under Supaul Bhaptiahi roadside Protected Forest.
