

**SITE INSPECTION REPORT NOT BELOW THE RANK OF DCF
(For the forest land to be diverted under FCA)**

A proposal has been received by this office from South East U.P. Power transmission company limited Lucknow, U.P for diversion (under FCA-1980) of 2.1504 ha. Of protected forest land for non forestry purpose. The project envisages the use of protected forest land for laying of transmission line over the Khaga-Kishunpur road, Khakhru-Kot road, Shivrajpur-Chilla road, Joraha-Amauli road, Khajaha- Amauli road, Bindki-Jahanabad road, Bakewer-Chaudagra road, Devmal-Shakoara road, Fatehpur-Gajpur road, Fatehpur- Banda road (NH-232), Gajpur- Asolher road, Itaule-Bharshol Mang, Rai Mainer & Lower Ganga canal District: Fatehpur (Uttar Pradesh)

The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has been done by me on dated 16-08-2022

On inspection of the site, it is found that the land required by the user agency is a forest measuring 2.1504 ha.

The requirement of protected forest land as proposed by the user agency in Col. 2 of part-I is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.
