NOTIFICATION

S.O. 3446 Whereas by the notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Energy (Department of Coal) No. S.O. 2640 dated 15th May, 1985 under sub-section (1) of section 7 of the Coal Bearing Areas (Acquisition and Development) Act, 1957 (20 of 1957) and published in Part II, Section 3, sub-section (ii) of the Gazette of India dated the 8th June, 1985, the Central Government gave notice of its intention to acquire land and rights in the locality specified in the schedule appended to that notification;

And whereas the competent authority in pursuance of section 8 of the said Act has made his report to the Central Government;

And whereas the Central Government after considering the report aforesaid and after consulting the Government of Maharashtra is satisfied that the lands measuring 160.41 hectares (approximately) or 396.36 acres (approximately) described in the schedule appended hereto should be acquired.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 9 of the Coal Bearing Areas (Acquisition and Development) Act, 1957 (20 of 1957), the Central Government hereby declares that the lands measuring 160.41 hectares (approximately) or 396.36 acres (approximately) described in the said schedule;

are hereby acquired.

The plan No. C-1(E)/3/JR/309-1285 dated 9th December, 1985 of the area covered by this notification may be inspected in the Office of the Collector, Chandrapur (Maharashtra) or in the Office of the Coal Controller, 1, Council House Street, Calcutta or in the office of the Western Coalfields Limited (Revenue Section), Coal Estate, Civil Lines, Nagpur (Maharashtra).

Boundary description :

A-B : Line starts from eastern bank of Erai river and passes
through village Kitadi along the northern boundary of
plot numbers 13, 14, 2, 1, crosses road, 88/1, then
in plot numbers 87, 85/2, 86 Abadi, 80, 81 and meets
in plot number 81 at point 'B'.

B-C : Line passes through village Kitadi in plot numbers 81,
80 and proceeds through village Padmapur, crosses road,
then in plot numbers 76, 77, 75, crosses Chandrapur-Taraha
P.W.D. road and then in plot numbers 149, 154, Abadi,
156 and meets in plot number 156 at point 'C'.

C-D : Line passes through village Padmapur in plot number 156,
crosses road, proceeds partly along the northern boundary
of plot number 131, then in plot numbers 130, 124, 158
and meets on the centre point of Motaghat Nallah at
point 'D'.

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- D-E - Line passes through village Padmapur from the center
F-G - Point of Motaghat Nallah and in plot numbers 159,
H - 125, then proceeds through village Sinhala in plot numbers 78, 85, 87, 88, 91, 90, 93, 92, then along the eastern boundary of plot numbers 67, 65/1 and in plot numbers 62, 59, crosses Nallah, then proceeds along the common boundary of villages Sinhala and Durgapur and meets at point 'H'.
- H-I : Line passes through village Durgapur in plot numbers 76, 75, 74, 72, 70, 46 and proceeds through village Sinhala, crosses nallah, then in plot numbers 73, 74, 75, 76 and then through village Padmapur in plot numbers 126, 159, crosses Motaghat Nallah, 158, 134, 143/3, 144, 143/1, 142 and meets on the eastern boundary of Chandrapur-Taroba P.W.D. road at point 'I'.
- I-J : Line passes through village Padmapur along the eastern boundary of Chandrapur-Taroba P.W.D. road and meets at point 'J'.
- J-K : Line passes through village Padmapur, crosses Chandrapur-Taroba P.W.D. road, then proceeds along the northern boundary of Gaathan Abadi, plot numbers 3, 70, 69, 68, 67, 66, 65 and meets on the common boundary of plot numbers 61, 71/2 and 71/3 at point 'K'.
- K-L : Line passes through village Padmapur along the western boundary of plot number 71/2, then in plot number 71/3, crosses road and proceeds through village Kitadi along the common boundary of plot numbers 80, 86 and meets at point 'L'.
- L-M : Line passes through village Kitadi along the northern boundary of plot number 86, crosses road, then partly along and partly through northern boundary of plot number 2, then in plot number 13 and meets on the eastern bank of Erci River at point 'M'.

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1-A : Line passes through village Kitadi along the eastern bank of Erad river and meets at the starting point 'A'.
