Sub: Request for reopening/reconsideration of Proposal No. FP/WB/MIN/26869/2017 for diversion of 109.459ha forest for Gourangdih ABC Coal Mine of WBMDTCL.

Ref: Letter in Memo No. 8-03/2019FC dated 17.08.2023 of AIG Forests, MDEFCC, New Delhi [Annexure-1]

Sir,

In reference to the above, this is to submit the following for your kind consideration;

- i) The coal mine was allocated to WBMDTCL by the Ministry of Coal, Govt. of India in September, 2016 along with an approved mining plan prepared in 2011 by the prior allottee of the coal block who did not operate the mine.
- ii) Operationalisation of the mine, inter alia, required diversion of 109.459 Ha of forest land (protected forest). Accordingly, WBMDTCL made the above referred Application (Proposal No. FP/WB/MIN/26869/2017) through Parivesh Portal in July-2017 for diversion of 109.459 Ha forest.
- iii) After passing through several stages of scrutiny, field inspections, EDS etc. by the concerned authorities of the State and Central Govt. and subsequent compliance/clarifications by WBMDTCL, the proposal was forwarded by State Government to MoEFCC Head Office on 10.03.2023. [Ref. EDS History given at Annexure-2].
- iv) The Advisory Committee (AC), MoEFCC, New Delhi considered the proposal in its meeting on 24.03.2023 and, *inter alia*, observed the following;
 - a) There were contradictions in respect of the pre-mining land uses mentioned in the 2011 mining plan and those of the FC application and advised submission of mining plan as per extant guideline.
 - b) The AC in its said meeting on 24.03.2023 also constituted a Sub-Committee to visit the area and submit report.
- v) Immediately thereafter on 30.03.2023, WBMDTCL had applied for revision of the 2011 mining plan to the Ministry of Coal, Gol.
- vi) The AC Sub-committee visited site on 29.05.2023 and, *inter alia*, also advised to submit the revised mining plan incorporating corrected land use map.
- vii) The proposal was subsequently returned by Nodal Officer (through CCF/DFO) to WBMDTCL on 17.07.2023 in Parivesh Portal with direction/EDS for compliance of site visit recommendations of the Sub-Committee. [Ref. Annexure-2]

- viii) riowever, the Advisory Committee, MoEFCC Head Office simultaneously took up the proposal in its meeting on 17.07.2023 itself at a time when it was actually pending for EDS compliance at WBMDTCL (User Agency) end on PARIVESH portal. The AC, MoEFCC eventually rejected the proposal on 17.07.2023 for non-compliance of EDS.
- Thus, obviously WBMDTCL (User Agency) did not get reasonable time for compliance of the EDS dated 17.07.2023, and the AC, MoEFCC did not actually have the requisite materials before it, viz., the EDS compliance report, supporting documents, views/ recommendation of the State Government etc. while it considered and eventually rejected the proposal on 17.07.2023.
- Subsequently, the Ministry of Coal has approved the revised Mining Plan on 09.10.2023 X) which has been uploaded at S. No. 09 of Additional Information Details on PARIVESH Portal.
- Thus, compliances of all observations of the Advisory Committee as well as the AC Subxi) Committee's EDS, along with all requisite documents including approved revised mining plan, have now been uploaded in PARIVESH portal.
- xii) It is further clarified as follows;
 - a) There has been no change in the proposal in terms of scope, purpose and other important aspects.
 - b) All the required information has been made available, and
 - c) Delay in providing information was mainly because of the delay in granting approval of the revised Mining Plan by Ministry of Coal, GoI which was beyond the control of WBMDTCL (User Agency).
- xiii) De novo submission of the proposal at this stage would further delay starting of the mine.

In view of the above, it is prayed that the Proposal No. FP/WB/MIN/26869/2017 for diversion of 109.459 ha forest for Gourangdih ABC Coal Mine of WBMDTCL may kindly be reopened and reconsidered in the light of the compliance report in respect of the EDS dated 24.03.2023 given at Annexure - 3, and the compliance report of the observations of Sub-Committee given at Annexure - 4.

Your kind cooperation and an early action in this matter would be immensely helpful in starting of the project that has been considerably delayed due to various reasons beyond the control of WBMDTCL.

Subject: Diversion of 109.459 ha of forest land for Open Cast Coal Mining Project at Gourangdih ABC coal mine in favour of WB Mineral Development and Trading Corporation under Durgapur Forest Division, West Bengal.

Madam/Sir,

I am directed to refer to the subject cited proposal and to convey that the instant proposal has been considered by Advisory Committee (AC) in its meeting held on 17.07.2023. The detailed minutes of the meeting are available on PARIVESH portal at www.parivesh.nic.in.

- 2. The Advisory Committee had detailed discussion and deliberation with Nodal officer (FCA), West Bengal and concerned Dy. Director General of Forest(C), Regional Office. After going through the facts of the proposal and the report of the sub-committee constituted on the recommendation of AC by Ministry on 24.04.2023, the Advisory Committee observed that:
 - i. The revised mining plan for the instant proposal is yet to be approved by the Ministry of Coal. In view of this, the land use needs be revised and their details with map are to be uploaded on PARIVESH portal.
 - ii. The safety zone along the periphery of the proposed mining area has not been marked by the user agency.
 - iii. The user agency has not explored the possibilities of identifying the dumping areas outside the forest area.
 - iv. The reply on Ministry's letter dated 24.04.2023, as sought on the recommendation of AC on 24.03.2023, has not yet been received from Govt. of West Bengal.
 - v. The Ministry vide its letter dated 20.06.2023 shared the sub-committee report with Government of West Bengal with a request for providing para-wise comments. The same was also not provided by the State Government.
- 3. Keeping in view the above observations, the recommendation of the Advisory

Committee and with the approval of the competent authority, it has been decided that the proposal cannot be acceded to in present proposition and the same is therefore rejected. The User agency will however be at liberty to submit the complete proposal *denovo*.

A. Compliance of the observations made by the FAC in its meeting dated 24.03.2023 (Ref. File No. 8-03/2019FC).

Para Observation No The total area involved in the project is 356.575 ha, comprising of 247.116 ha of non-forest land and 109.459 ha of forest land. Corresponding detail of area mentioned in the approved Mining Plan are different wherein total area has been mentioned as 370 ha comprising of 92.53 ha of forest land and 277.47 ha of non-forest land. The State Govt. has mentioned that as per Rule 22E (3) (i) of the Mineral Concession (Amendment) Rules, 2020, this change in land type within lease area comes under 'minor changes' in the approved mining plan and does not require fresh approval of the mining plan. The Rule 22E (3)(i) however refers to the "change in land type within the leased area" as a 2. minor change, whereas in the instant case the area has been reduced from 370 ha to 356.575 ha. Moreover 65.09 ha additional area has been taken outside the block. The purpose/component wise breakup of the required area has to be in conformity with the mining plan. The same needs to be examined by the State Government. The State Govt. shall ensure to submit the miningplan as required under extant guidelines.

- 2. The AC, after detailed deliberation with Nodal officer (FCA), Govt. of West Bengal, Regional Officer, IRO, Kolkata and Chief Managing Director, WB Mineral Development & Trading Corporation and after going through the facts of the proposal, deferred the proposal with the following observations:

- 3. In view of above, Government of West Bengal is requested to provide their response on the points as indicated at para 2 [(i) to (iii)] above for further consideration of the proposal in the Ministry.

1. BASELINE STATUS OF TRAFFIC DENSITY

1.1 Monitoring location

The traffic density survey was conducted both in up and down direction at three locations namely Baradang (0.9 km from the proposed mine in S direction), Majandih (1.6 km from the proposed mine in NE direction) and Dharaspur (3.5 km from the proposed mine in WSW direction) on 03-04/01/2018, 07-08/01/2018 and 10-11/01/2018, respectively. The locations are shown in **Fig 1**.

1.2 Methodology

Traffic density was recorded continuously for 24 hours during the monitoring days by visual observation and counting of vehicles under six categories, viz., heavy motor vehicles (buses & truck), light motor vehicles, cycles, motor cycles & scooters, animal drawn vehicles and others. As traffic density on the road is low, one skilled person was deployed during each shift. At the end of each hour, fresh counting and recording was undertaken. Thus, total numbers of vehicles per hour under each category was determined. Report of the study is given at Annexure -1


The result of presence of slow moving vehicles in traffic stream is that it affects the free flow of traffic. A way of accounting for the interaction of various kind of vehicles is to express the capacity of roads in terms of common unit. Therefore, the number of vehicles have been converted into "passenger car units" (PCUs) using the equivalency factor as per Table 1 of IRC: 64-1990 and the volume of traffic on the three routes are summarised in Table 1.

The condition of the road at Baradang and Majandih is good and it is well maintained. Whereas the road near Dharaspur is having road width only 3 m, which needs widening and maintenance. From the perusal of Table 3.16, it is found that at Baradang, current utilisation is 43.0% of maximum capacity of the road, at Majandih the current utilization is 32.9% of maximum capacity of the road and at Dharaspur, the current utilization is 56.0% of maximum capacity of the road.

2. ANTICIPATED IMPACT DUE TO TRAFFIC AND MITIGATION MEASURES

There in only one outgoing material, which is coal. The transportation shall be carried out through road either directly to end user or till railway siding by tipping trucks/ dumper having capacity 25 T. Total material to be transported is estimated around 7576 TPD (assuming total working days as 330 and production 2.5 MT of coal in a year). Since the end users will be various industries across the different states, hence the direction of movement of trucks cannot be exactly identified. Certain assumptions have been made with respect to the routes shown in **Fig 2**. The assumptions made are as follows:

- (i) Transport of coal directly till end user by road via Asansol-Gourangdih road. 1 MTPA coal shall be transported through this road. Approximately 244 trucks (to and fro) will move through this road. This route has been called as "Route-2" in **Fig 2**.
- (ii) Transportation of coal via road to any of the four railway sidings, namely, Bonjemehari, Barabani, Charanpur or Chinchuria railway siding. Approximately 1.5 MTPA will be moved to consumers through this road-rail combination. Approximately 364 trucks will move on these routes called as Route 1, Route 3, Route 4 and Route 5 of **Fig 2.**

The traffic survey was conducted as per IRC: 9-1972 at three locations namely Baradang, Majandih and Dharaspur in the up and down directions. Baradang location falls on Gourangdih-Asansol road (Route-2) and Dharaspur location falls on Rupnarayanpur-Gourangdih road i.e connecting road (Route-1) to Bonjemehari railway siding through which coal transportation is proposed. There will be an impact on carrying capacity of these two roads due to additional traffic load. Therefore, the adequacy of the road to support the additional traffic, its maximum capacity and the percentage utilization of the maximum capacity has been calculated. This has been done with respect to existing and future traffic load and the increment in utilization of maximum capacity has been calculated in **Table 2**

FIG 2: THE PROPOSED RAILWAY SIDING AND CONNECTING ROADS TO BE USED FOR TRANSPORTATION OF COAL



It can be seen in the above table that the resultant traffic load on Asansol-Gourangdig road (Route-2) at Baradang loacation will be 49.1 % of the Maximum capacity of the road. Where as on Rupnarayanpur-Gourangdih road (Route-1) at Dharaspur location, the resultant traffic load will be 83.8 % of Maximum capacity the roads. Thus it can be said that the current road width of both the location is sufficient to sustain the present and additional traffic.

2.2 Road diversion

There are two existing road passing through the core zone namely,

- (i) Road-1: **Asansol-Gourangdih road connecting Runakura ghat via Jamgram** is having width of about 7 m (PWD road), passing through the eastern part of proposed Gourangdih C quarry.
- (ii) Road-2: **Rupnarayanpur-Gourangdih road** is having width of about 3 m (Village road), connecting Gourangdih and Rupnarayanpur, passing through the western portion of Gourangdih-A quarry.

These two roads will get excavated during mining operation. Hence, for uninterrupted traffic flow, diversion of these roads is necessary which shall be as follows:

(i) Road-1: Asansol-Gourangdih road, connecting Asansol to Runakuraghat via Jamgram village is proposed to be diverted towards further east of the Gourangdih quarry-C.

(i) Road-2: The Rupnarayanpur-Gourangdih road is proposed to be diverted towards further west of the Gourangdih quarry-A and will be connected to Asansol-Gourangdih road.


Both the roads will be reconstructed after diversion to a road width equivalent to their existing width.

Apart from the road diversion, road from Gourangdih village to proposed diversion of Rupnarayanpur-Gourangdih road (about 300 m in length), is also proposed to be made black topped/CC road (Road 3). Partly metalled road already exists on the road, which will have to be further strengthened.

The proposed diversion of Road-1 and 2 and strengthening of Road 3 are shown in 15th year stage plan given in **Fig 3**.

The impact will be there only on the path of the road due to alignment change but there will not be any adverse impact. Tree plantation is proposed along both the sides of the diverted road routes, which will act as an absorber of dust and noise pollution and also will improve the aesthetic view of the area.


