e)	Whether a letter certifying that discussions and decisions on such proposals and taken place only when there was a quorum of minimum 50% of members of the Grama Sabha present.	
f)	Whether the written consent or rejection of the Grama Sabha to the proposal has been obtained or produced?	
g)	Whether a letter certifying that the rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities, where applicable, have been specifically safeguarded as per section 3(1)(e) of FRA.	
h)	Any other aspect having bearing on operationalisation of the FRA.
