JOINT INSPECTION REPORT

Joint-inspection Report of construction of 33/11 KV, 1*3.15 MVA Substation at Sh. Naina Devi Ji, in the state of Himachal Pradesh, was done on 17-06-2021 in the presence of undersigned officers. In this Joint Inspection, it has been ensured that least forest area and lesser number of trees are involved in this construction of the Substation. It has also been ensured that there is least adverse impact on the environment.

During this joint inspection three alternative sites have been examined which are as below:-

Alternative-1 (Proposed Alignment)

Under this alternative, the area of the proposed land for the construction of 33/11 KV, 1*3.15 MVA Substation at Sh. Naina Devi Ji, is 0.20 Hect. Forest land.

Alternative-2

Under this Alternative, the proposed land for construction of 33/11 KV, 1*3.15 MVA Substation at Sh. Naina Devi Ji, acquires Forest Land 0.25 Hectare. But there is no Proper approach to the said proposed area.

Alternative-3

Under this alternative, the proposed land for construction of /11 KV, 1*3.15 MVA Substation at Sh. Naina Devi Ji, for the diversion of 0.27 which passes through Forest land acquires steep slopes, narrow width of workable plain area, narrow road and not easily approachable.

Since the involvement of the forest land as on the lesser side In <u>Alternative-1</u>, so the <u>Alternative-1</u> has been recommended.

On inspection of site, it is found that:-

- For the construction of the proposed scheme, total area of forest land will be 0.20
 Hectare.
- 2. The proposed land is minimum or unavoidable for the construction of said scheme.

- In the above area, there is no species of vegetation which is prone to extinction.
- There is no rare/endangered/unique species of flora and fauna found in the area.
- The user agency has not violated the provision of Forest (Conservation) Protection Law, act 1980
- Therefore the proposed area is declared compulsory and inaccessible or there will be no change in this. Even saying that this matter is related to national and public interest. Recommendation for approval under forest protection law, 1980.
