



Footnote : The Schedule to the National Highways Act, 1956 (48 of 1956) was substituted vide notification number S.O. 689(E), dated 4th April, 2011 published in the Gazette of India, dated the 4th April, 2011 and subsequently amended vide notifications number S.O. 2017(E), dated 29th April, 2022.

The Ministry of Road Transport and Highways (MoRTH) through National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) has decided to develop the proposed project to improve the efficiency of freight movement in India under Bharatmala Pariyojana. The National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) has entrusted M/s K & J-Projects Pvt Ltd with the assignment of preparation of feasibility study / Detailed project report of road stretch which starts near Shamli (Ch. 0+000) and ends at Sadopur village in Ambala district (Ch.120+970) in the State of Uttar Pradesh and Haryana. Total length of the proposed alignment is 120.970 Km.

The proposed 6 lane expressway (Greenfield) will be a prime link connecting many small villages to major cities, which after development will provide commercial enhancement to the Project Influence area.
