Diversion of 32.357 ha. forest land under Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 for construction of Alyani Minor Irrigation Scheme in Parhe Village in Dist. Thane in the State of Maharashtra (FP/MH/IRRIG/23779/2017).

The Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Maharashtra State, Nagpur has submitted proposal for diversion of 32.357 ha. forest land under Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 for construction of Alyani Minor Irrigation Scheme in Parhe Village in Dist. Thane in the State of Maharashtra.

2. The proposal has been initiated by the Executive Engineer, Small Irrigation (W.C) Division, Kalwa, Thane for approval under Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam. 1980. The non-forest land involved in the project is 17.792 ha. proposed Minor Irrigation Scheme is located across a local nall near Village Tal. Murbad, Dist. Thane in the village Alyani is located at a distance about 25 Kms away from Murbad Taluka. The proposed dam site is about 1.5 Km from Village Dhasai and situated in Village Alyani. The dam site latitude 19-15'30" and longitude about 73.34"30" with reference to Toposheet No.47/E/11 and 47/E/12. The proposed Alyani Minor Irrigation a earthen dam, waste weir, R.C.C Well type sluice, H.R on the local nalla on the local nalla having canal 4.20 Km. L.B.G is proposed to irrigate 214 ha. of land there is no scope for considering alternative site considering the Storage and other aspect.

For this scheme both the private and forest land needs to be acquired by the User Agency. The catchment area is 0.77 sq. Miles 1.99 Sq. Km the Catchment area is hilly and free with very good yield. The rain fall data has been collected from the nearest rain gauge station at The 50% dependable rainfall is 217.32 cm and yield 3560.96 T.Cum gross storage is proposed 2660,720 T. Cum.

The proposed length of Dam is 536 Mtr and Maximum height of dam in gorge portion is 20.90 Mtr the earthen dam consists of hearting and casing imperious and previous soil respectively. The top width of dam 0.60 dam is 0.60 Mtr. Top level is 100.00 M.H.FL is 98.50 M and FSL. is 97.50 Mtr, 0.30 M pitching is proposed on either side of dam with 0.15 m. thick. Quarry spoil bedding on LIP stream slop up to 0.50 m. below still level. The rock toe is proposed up to H/s height of dam at Down Stream of dam 1.00 m. thick sand Filter is

provided to only outer slope of hearting. Additional berms of 6.0 M & & 7.0 width at 89.50 M. level and 79.50 level are provided on the upstream and Downstream slopes are as G.R. No. MHD/108/142/120/80, dated 21/04/1986.

3. The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Thane Forest Division, Thane has certified that:-

- 3.1 No suitable alternate land is available and the forest land required is barest minimum.
- 3.2 The area belongs to Eco-value class-I having density is below 0.3.
- 3.3 There are 797 trees involved the project out of which 383 trees required to be felled. The various species and trees is involved in implementation of the project the girth wise break up is as under:-

As per the Government of India, MoEF letter dated 30/01/2009 has mentioned that "No tree felling in the area between FRL, and 4 m. below FRL shall be carried out for the Minor Irrigation proposals. In this regard the actual tree felling for the said proposal is 383 required to be felled.

- 3.4 The area involved in the project does not form part of any existing National Park. Wildlife Sanctuary, Nature Reserve etc.
- 3.5 Proposed project is not likely to affect any monumental site of cultural, historical. Religious, archaeological or recreational importance.
- 3.6 There is no violation of Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980
- 3.7 Proposed Project area for the project is 6.270 Km away from the boundary of the Protected Area (Sanctuary & National Park)

In this regard, this office vide office note dated 01/02/2022 has sought remarks in this matter to PCCF (WL) State of Maharashtra. Accordingly, the PCCF (WL), State of Maharashtra has offer comments and informed that "Alyani Small Irrigation Scheme, Post. Murbad District the proposed area for Thane is 6.270 Km from the boundary of the eco-sensitive zone of Bhimashankar Wildlife Sanctuary. The said area is declared as Environmentally Sensitive Zone (ESZ) of Bhimashankar Sanctuary vide notification no.2633 (E), dated 05/08/2020 not included, the proposal does not need to be approval by the Wildlife Board."

- 3.8 The non-forest area covered under the project is not under the provision of Maharashtra Private Forest (Acquisition) Act 1975 by virtue of of Section 35 of Indian Forest Act 1927 and are not recognized as deemed reserved forest as well as not included in the area identified as "forest" as per dictionary meaning of forest as intimated to the expert committee appointed under interim judgment of the Hon'ble Supreme Court dated 12/12/1996.
- 3.9 Proposed Compensatory Afforestation over 32.36 ha. non forest land (i) 20.00 ha. in Survey No.308 at Village Jagji, Tal. Osmanabad, Dist. Osmanabad (ii) 12.36 ha. in Gut at Village Nilegaon, Tal & Dist. Osmanabad is contiguous, suitable for afforestation and management purpose and it is free from encroachment and an encumbrances.
- 3.10 The cost benefit analysis ration is 2.55.

4. The User Agency has submitted undertakings:-

- 4.1 to defray the cost of compensatory afforestation.
- 4.2 to defray the cost of Net Present Value of the forest land proposed for diversion.

5. The Collector, Thane has given certified that:-

The certificate of Collector, Thane under Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Right) Act, 2006 issued vide letter No.RB/Desk-IV/T- IUFRA-NOC/CR-11/15, dated 30/10/2020 issued in Form II as per Government of India latest guidelines dated 5/7/2013.

- 6. Deputy Conservator of Forest, Thane & Chief Conservator of Forests (T). Thane have recommended the proposal for approval under Section-2 of the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhinyam, 1980.
- 7. Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests & Nodal Officer, Maharashtra State. Nagpur, has recommended the proposal subject to the conditions, given in his recommendations, under Section-2 (ii) of the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhinyam, 1980. His recommendations are enclosed in the proposal.
- 8. The Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Maharashtra State, Nagpur has recommended the proposal subject to the conditions, given in his specific recommendations, under Section-2 (ii) of the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhinyam, 1980. His specific recommendations are enclosed in the proposal.
- 9. In the circumstances explained in the aforesaid paragraphs and enclosures, the State Government recommends that the said forest land may be allowed to be diverted subject the conditions proposed by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF). Maharashtra State, Nagpur as well as following additional conditions:-
 - (1) Deputy Conservator of Forests, Thane shall ensure that proposed Chowki is not on Forest land.

- (2) A perusal of the KML file shows that the access road proposed in the project has a large amount of trees. Therefore, Deputy Conservator of Forests, Thane shall ensure there is no cutting of trees.
- (3) Deputy Conservator of Forests, Thane shall submit Revise Site Inspection Report, along with Stage-I compliance.
- (4) User Agency shall submit Technical Sanction order, along with Stage-I compliance.
- (5) User Agency shall submit Record of Rights of Proposed land at Survey/Gut. no. 37 of Village- Kundali, Survey/Gut. no. 56/1 pt. of Village- Mahaj, Survey/Gut. no. 5 & 53 of Village- Alyani, along with Stage-I compliance.
- (6) User Agency shall submit updated certificate of the Collector, Thane under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006, along with the Stage-1 Compliance Report.
- (7) User Agency shall compensate private land holders as per prevalent Act and Rules.
- (8) User Agency shall submit no objection certificate of private land holders, along with Stage-I compliance.
- (9) Deputy Conservator of Forests, Thane & User Agency shall submit updated revised documents, along with Stage-I compliance.
- (10) A perusal of the KML File shows that CCT work and tree plantation has already been done on the area proposed for Compensatory afforestation at Survey No. 308 at Jagji and Survey No. 176 at-Nilegaon. Further necessary action will be taken after re-investigation in this regard.
- (11) Divisional Forest Officer, Dharashiv shall submit a Compensatory afforestation Scheme for the Gut. No.176 of Nilegaon, along with Stage-I compliance.
- (12) The Divisional Forest Officer, Dharashiv will ensure that the proposed lands at
 Jagji and Nilegaon proposed for Compensatory afforestation are not given for Compensatory afforestation for any other project.

The matter may kindly be placed before the Government of India for its approval under Section-2 (ii) of the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhinyam, 1980.
