XIV-(A)-3/65.—Pursuant to Rule (10) of the United Khasi Jaintia Hills Autonomous District (Management and Control of Forests Rates of Royalty) Rules, 1949, it is hereby notified for general information that for the year ending 31st March 1966, the royalty on all minor forest produce shall be charged as specified hereunder.

The rate is charged per quintal, a quintal is equal to 100 Kilograms or 2 mounds 27 scores in the old system of measurement.
