

Recommendation

A proposal has been received from Deputy General Manager, JIO Digital Fiber Private Limited, No.51, RMZ Icon, Place Cross Road, Vasanth Nagar, Bengaluru for diversion of 1.53939 ha. forest land for laying underground optical fiber cable along the right of way of NH66(17) and NH63. As per the proposal on verification of ground on 08-10-2022 only 1.13136 ha. area falls in forest land instead of 1.53939 ha. The survey number wise extent of forest land detailed is as under:
