
In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (11-9/98-FC(pt) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 ("FRA, for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purpose read with MoEF's letter dated 5th February 2013 wherein MoEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects.

It is certified that, as per the guidelines of Government of India, the corridor width of 11 KV HT ABC Cable line has to be taken as 7 meter and therefore 0.380 Hectares of forest lands comprised in S.Nos.466, 478, 479, 480, 481, 482, 483, 484, 485, 486, 487, 488 and 489 an total extent of 145.24.5 Hectares of Sirungundram Village of Thiruporur Taluk in Chengalpattu District is proposed to be diverted in favour of the Superintending Engineer/TANGEDCO/Chengalpattu for the erection of poles and ABC Cable for the proposes 11 KV ABC cable line in the existing Sirungundram Main Road from Chengalpattu to Thiruporur Main Road to Sirungundram Village in Chengalpattu District.

It is further certified that :

- (a) the proposed area does not involve recognized rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities.
- (b) There is no alternative vacant/Government land available near Sirungundram forest for erection of 11 KV Aerial Bunched Cable Line to M/s.SICAME India Connectors Pvt.Limited, under CSR Project.
