In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and forests (MOEF), Government of India's letter No.11-98 FC (pt) dated 3rd August 2009 wherein the MOEF issued guidelines in submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 (FRA, for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that 3.5062 Hecrates of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of south western railway for laying double railway line between Oddarahalli & Makalidurga Railway Station. In the state of Karnataka in Bengaluru Rural district falls within jurisdiction of Hadonahalli, Kelaginanaykarandahalli and Thirumagondanahalli villages in Doddaballapura Tehsils.

It is further certified that :

- (a) In the forest area falls within jurisdiction of Hadonahalli, Kelaginanaykarandahalli and Thirumagondanahalli villages in Doddaballapura Tehsils, which is proposed for diversion has no tribal settlement and also no traditional forest dwellers are located in the proposed forest land diversion area. Hence the issue of resettlement and rehabilitation in 3,5062 hectors under FRA 2006 act doesnot arise.
- (b) the diversion of the forest land facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3(2) of the FRA does not arise as there are no tribal's or other forest traditional forest wellers, the concerned gram panchayat have given their opinion about the same.
- (c) the proposal does not involve recognized rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural Committees.
