4. Situation: Situated on the south eastern slope of Chorta Dhar.

Boundaries

- North: Sub Comp. 1a & 1b & mauser boundary.
 East: -do- 2a and UP 126 P Dir-IC1.
 South: UP 126 P Dir-I C.1 and C2.
 West: sub compartment 4a, 4b, 3a and 3c.

Locality Factors:

- (i) Elevation: 1875 m to 2470 m.
 (ii) Aspect: Various mainly southern and western
 (iii) Slope: Very steep to precipitous
 (iv) Rock: Gneiss and Mica Schist
 (v) Soil: Shallow, micaceous loam
 (vi) Humus: Adequate in the form of undecomposed layers
 (vii) Drainage: Well drained into Uhl Khad.

6. Forest type/sub-type: 12 C2a Kheru oak forests
 12 C1a Ban Oak forests.

Growing Stock:

- (i) General:

Mainly the compartment is having mature to over-mature trees of Ban Oak with light admixture of mature spruce trees alongwith Kheru oak on higher reaches south-easterly. The average density of Ban Oak alongwith other associates is 0.5 to 0.4 having lower height growth towards upper reaches of the comp. Three large blanks are present along Chorta Dhar. Inspection hut is also present on the ridge near Bilang. Numerous included cultivations and scrubland in the compartment.

(ii) Over wood: Ban oak

(b) Age classed: Mainly mature with few young
(c) Density: 0.5

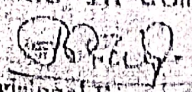
