Contours are approximate.
A relative height, *dr*, represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
Wooded areas are coloured green. Scattered trees and other vegetation are in green, but prominent surveyed trees are in black.

The kilometre scale numbers along roads are shown in blue, e.g. '14' whereas kilometre numbers are shown in upright type, e.g. '5'.
Shaded or non-shaded areas occur throughout the map; they are normally shaded after 3-3 years and are not shown.
The triangulated heights and contours in this sheet have not been adjusted to the heights of the spirit-levelled bench-marks and may not be strictly in accordance with them.
