Undertaking for Environmental Clearance

Ministry of Coal, Government of India vide vesting order under clause (b) of sub-rule 7 and sub-rule (1) of rule 13 and vesting order no NA-104/2/2019-NA, dated February 10, 2020 allotted Brahampuri Coal Mine in favour of Birla Corporation Limited for mining of coal for captive use to meet the requirement of coal to End Use Plants at Chanderia, Rajasthan and Satna, Madhya Pradesh.

In accordance with the provisions of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, Birla Corporation Limited, hereby gives an undertaking that the Company will seek Environmental Clearance under Environmental Protection Act, 1986 and subsequent Rules and Regulations framed thereafter for Brahampuri Coal Mine over an area of 360 Ha located in Pench – Kanhan coalfield under Bichhua Pathar, Chhinda, Kukurmunda, Sethia & Sirgoda villages and Forest Block: 61-Thaori, Parasia Tehsil, Chhindwara district of Madhya Pradesh for exploitation of coal by underground method.

The Brahampuri Coal Mine will commence only after obtaining Environmental clearance.
