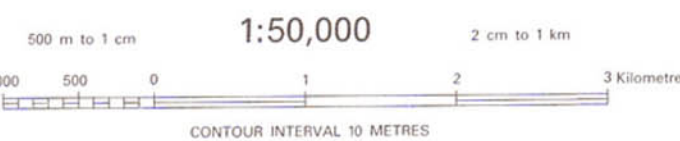
NOTES :-

A relative height, h_r , represents the approximate height, in metres, between the top and bottom of a steep slope.
A relative height, h_r , marked along a canal, indicates the height of the top of the canal embankment above the adjacent country.
Canal distance stones are 1000 feet apart and every existing fifth stone is shown.
Tanks, shown dry, in this area usually contain water from July to December.
Tube-wells are numerous throughout the sheet, only the important ones have been shown.
3000-acre reclamation stones of Bhakra Dam Project Survey, based on Origin 30° 00' 74.75" E with their numbers are shown as tertiary bench-marks thus... F 322 BM 246.7
The exterior boundaries of areas of Reserved or Protected Forests are shown by green ribands.

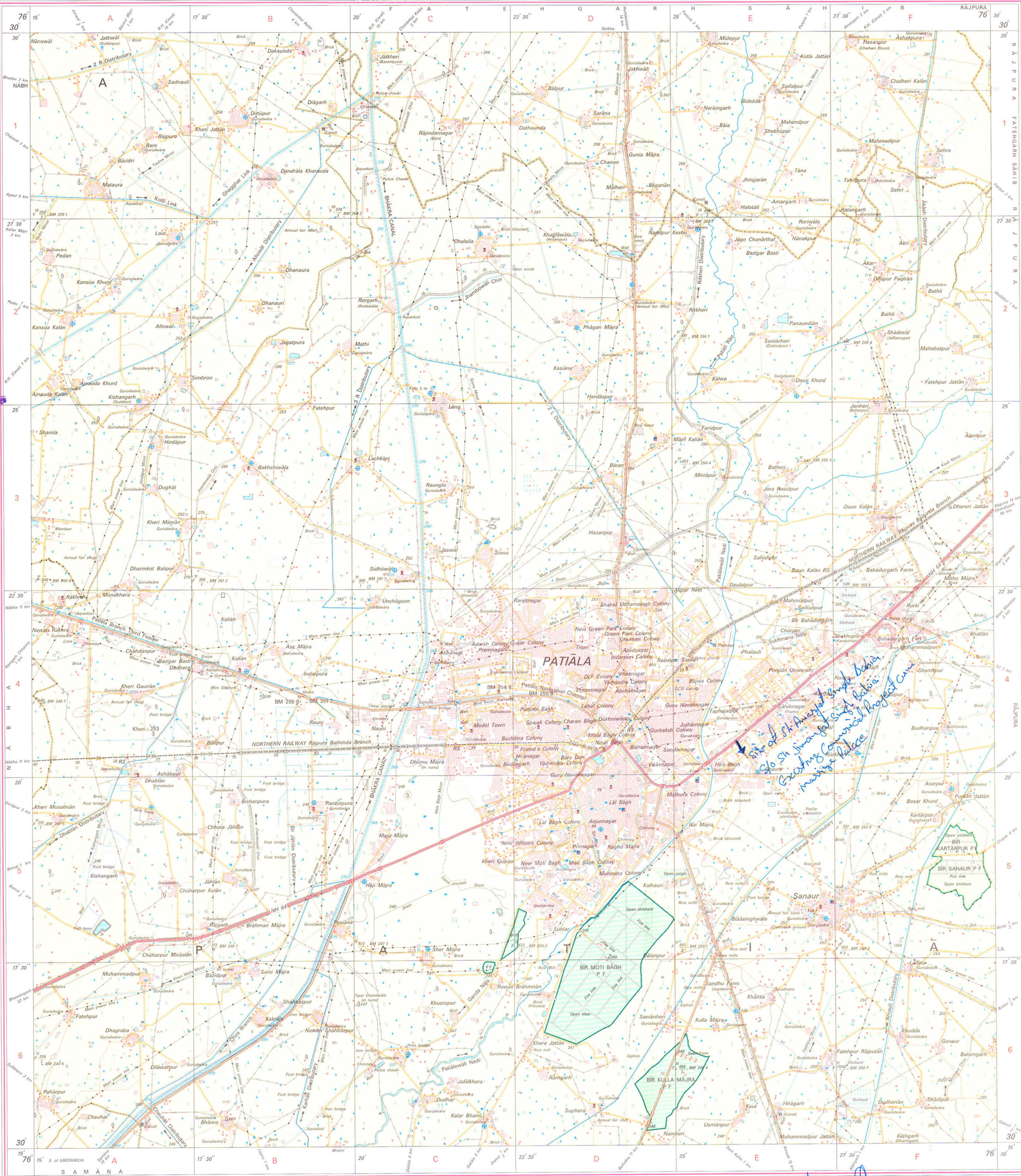


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
