It is notified for general information that, under Section 1 (3) of the Record of Rights Act No. X of 1927, Government are pleased to direct that the provisions of the said Act shall be extended to the settled Inam Village of Mulbodu in Shivmoga Taluk.

The Record is intended to check litigation in regard to land and to facilitate its disposal by the Courts, to reduce unnecessary expenditure by the ryots in executing and registering documents and to protect them against fraud and fabrication of false claims. It will also be of assistance to Government as well as the ryots in the distribution of assessment among the various hissadars, the grant of Takavi and Land Improvement Loans and the grant of suspension or remission of land revenue.

3. To facilitate the accurate preparation of the Record of Rights, the Preliminary Record will first be prepared by the Sthanbhogs to the best of their information in the prescribed form and every case will be duly investigated by a Special Revenue Inspector. There will be a check of the Preliminary Record by the Amildar or other officer specially authorized by the Superintendent of Land Records, Survey and Settlement or by the Deputy Commissioner, in this behalf. Occupants and persons interested in the land are required to furnish correct information that may be within their knowledge to the Investigating Officers in order to ensure accuracy in the preparation of this Record which will form the basis of the future Record of Rights.

4. All persons interested in the land are required to render every reasonable assistance to Officers of the Department of Land Records when they come to the village to measure the hissa and to conduct enquiries in cases of disputed boundary lines between hissas in the field after giving the prescribed notice.

5. The attention of the public is invited to the provisions of Section 7 of the Record of Rights Act requiring them on requisition by a Revenue Officer, engaged in compiling or revising the Record of Rights to furnish or produce information and documents needed for the correct compilation or revision thereof within one month from the date of such requisition. Failure to comply with this requisition and secure registration of their rights will render occupants and holders of interests in land liable to a fine not exceeding Rs. 5 (recoverable as an arrear of land revenue) besides depriving them of the advantages enumerated above. The officer to whom any information is furnished or before whom any documents are produced in accordance with the requisition will give a written acknowledgment thereon in the form prescribed to the person furnishing or producing the same and shall endorse on any such document, before returning it to him, a note under signature stating the fact of its production and the date thereof.





North.—Starting from the trijunction bands of Yemmedoddi, Anrit Mahal, Kaval, Pillehirahalli and Udevu Villages of Tavikere Taluk, the line runs east along the southern boundary of Survey No. 88 of Udevu Village for a distance of 50 chains and then turns slightly north-east and runs for a distance of 90 chains all along the southern boundary of the said Survey No. 88 of Udevu Village and meets the trijunction bands of Survey Nos. 82 and 80 of Udevu Village and 140 of Hogarehalli Village and then turns east and runs along the southern boundary of Survey No. 140 of Hogarehalli Village for a distance of 40 chains and turns slightly north-east and runs along the said Survey No. 140 of Hogarehalli for a distance of 10 chains and meets the junction bands of Survey Nos. 111 and 110 of Hogarehalli Village and turns east and runs for 6 chains and again turns north and runs for 8 chains along the southern and eastern boundaries of Survey No. 110 and turns slightly south-east and runs for about 7 chains along the southern boundaries of Survey Nos. 106 and 105 and turns and runs slightly north-east for a distance of 6 chains and meets the trijunction bands of Survey Nos. 105 and 108 of Hogarehalli Village and Yemmedoddi. Then the line runs slightly north-east and runs along the southern boundary of Survey No. 103 of Hogarehalli for a distance of 24 chains and turns south-east and runs for 4 chains in the south-easterly direction and for 4 chains in the north-easterly direction along the southern boundary of the said Survey No. and for 16 chains in the same direction along the southern boundary of Survey No. 140 of the said village and meets the trijunction bands of Survey Nos. 140 and 95 of Hogarehalli and Yemmedoddi. Then the line turns and runs for a distance of 70 chains in easterly direction along the southern boundary of Survey No. 95 of Hogarehalli Village and meets the quadri-junction bands of Yemmedoddi and Survey Nos. 77, 94 and 91 of Hogarehalli. Then the line turns north-east and runs for a distance of 133 chains along the eastern boundary of Survey No. 77 of Hogarehalli and meets the junction bands of Hogarehalli and Baliganoor Villages. Then the line turns east and runs for a distance of 68 chains along the southern boundary of Survey No. 101 of Baliganoor and turns north-east and runs for 38 chains and turns east and runs for 25 chains along the southern boundary of Survey No. 100 of Baliganoor Village and then turns and runs in a northerly and slightly north-westerly direction for a distance of 40 chains and 50 chains, respectively along the eastern boundary of Survey No. 100 of Baliganoor Village. Then the line turns and runs for a distance of 11 chains in a slightly north-easterly direction along the eastern boundary of the said survey number and meets the quadri-junction bands of Survey Nos. 100, 54 and 53 of Baliganoor Village and Devarahalli Kaval. Then the line turns south-east and runs for 19 chains and 21 chains along the southern boundary of Survey No. 7 of Devarahalli and meets the trijunction bands of Devarahalli Kaval, Hiriyangala Village and Yemmedoddi. Then the line turns east and runs for a distance of 82 chains along the southern boundaries of Survey Nos. 43 and 434 of Hiriyangala Village.

East.—Then the line turns and runs for distance of 13 chains along the western boundary of Survey No. 239 of Hiriyangala Village in a slightly south-westerly direction and then turns south and runs for a distance of 38 chains along the western boundaries of Survey Nos. 286, 285, 283, 282, 266, 265 and 264 of Hiriyangala Village and meets the trijunction bands of Survey Nos. 254 and 250 of Hiriyangala Village and Yemmedoddi. Then the line turns slightly south-west and runs for 26 chains along the northern boundary of Survey No. 250 of Hiriyangala Village and turns south and runs for 29 chains along the western boundary of the said survey number. Then the line turns east and runs for a distance of 90 chains along the southern boundaries of Survey Nos. 250 and 249 and meets the Kalla. Then the line turns slightly south-east and runs for about 10 chains along the western edge of the Kalla and 16 chains along the western boundary of Survey No. 173 of Hiriyangala Village and meets the junction bands of Hiriyangala, Outhanballi and Yemmedoddi situated at the northern edge of Kodiyalve at its turning point near the western corner of Survey No. 15 of Outhanballi Village. Then the line crosses the said kalve at its bend and runs all along the eastern bank of the said kalve in a zigzag manner for a distance of 150 chains along the western boundaries of the Survey Nos. 15, 16, 17, 20, 22, 23, 26 and 27 of Outhanballi Village and meets the south-western corner bands of last named survey number. Then the line turns east and runs for a distance of 15 chains along the southern boundary of Survey No. 27 and the southern edge of the channel and meets the junction bands of Yemmedoddi, Harnalghatta and Outhanballi Villages. Then the line turns and runs slightly south-west for a distance of 83 chains all along the western boundary of Survey No. 4 of Harnalghatta Village and meets the junction bands of Harnalghatta, Govindapur and Yemmedoddi. Then the line turns and runs due south for a distance of 28 chains along the western boundary of Survey No. 28 of Govindapur and runs slightly south-west for a distance of 32 chains along the western boundaries of Survey Nos. 27 and 267 of the said village and meets the junction bands of Channepaballi and Govindapur.

Then the line turns south and runs for a distance of 36 chains along the western boundary of Survey No. 25 of Ramachalli Village and here turns and runs south-east for a distance of 30 chains along the western boundary of Survey No. 25 of the said village and meets the junction bandhs of Bukkasagara, Ramachalli and Yemmedoddi. Then the line turns and runs west and runs for a distance of 89 chains along the northern boundary of Survey No. 17 of Bukkasagara Village and meets the northernmost corner bandhs of said survey number. Then the line turns and runs south-west for a distance of 48 chains and meets the junction bandhs at the western boundary of Survey No. 17 where it meets the north-eastern corner of the tank. Then the line turns and runs south for a distance of 36 chains along the western boundary of the said Survey No. 17 and then turns and runs south-east for a distance of 64 chains and meets the southernmost corner bandhs of the said Survey No. 17. Then the line turns and runs north-east for a distance of 28 chains till it meets the trijunction bandhs of Bukkasagara, Brahmasamudra and Yemmedoddi. Then the line turns and runs south-west for a distance of 28 chains along the northern boundary of Survey No. 302 of Brahmasamudra and then turns slightly south-east and crosses the Kadurmagalur high road, and runs for a distance of 64 chains along the western boundary of Survey No. 302 of Brahmasamudra and meets the trijunction bandhs of Brahmasamudra, Sakrepata and Yemmedoddi.

South.—Then the line turns north-west and runs for a distance of 48 chains along the northern boundary of S. No. 74 of Sakrepata Village till it meets the high road (Kadurmagalur). Then the line crosses the high road and turns due west and runs for a distance of 204 chains along the northern boundaries of Survey Nos. 713 and 742 of Sakrepata Village till it meets the junction bandhs of Sakrepata Village and Kamenu. Then the line turns north-west and runs for a distance of 64 chains and then turns south-west and runs for a distance of 133 chains along the northern boundary of Kamenuhally Kaval. Then the line turns and runs for a distance of 8 chains along the northern boundary of Kamenuhally Kaval and then turns south-west and runs for a distance of 8 chains along the northern boundary of Kamenuhally Kaval.

Whereas the Government of His Highness the Maharaja of Mysore are satisfied that there is a danger of the outbreak of plague at Beechaganahalli village in the Guduru Sub-Taluk, Kolar District, if persons from plague-infected areas in the Mysore State elsewhere are permitted to assemble in the place on the occasion of weekly shandies;

In exercise of the powers vested in them under the Mysore Epidemic Diseases Act of 1897, Government are pleased to prohibit the holding of the weekly shandies at Beechaganahalli village for a period of one month.

All persons proceeding to the shandy in contravention of this notification will be sent back.

In exercise of the powers conferred on them by sub-rule (2) of Rule 16 of the Mysore Rules of 1938 and in continuation of the Notification No. A. P. 3905—P. & T. 10-41-3, dated the 4th October 1941, the Government of His Highness the Maharaja of Mysore are pleased to make the following order namely :—

1. The working of wireless transmitting apparatus on board any aircraft is prohibited during any time when that aircraft is left unattended, for the purpose of preventing such working an aircraft which is fitted with wireless transmitting apparatus shall be left unattended unless there has been taken away from the wireless transmitting apparatus thereon at least one component part of such apparatus which is essential for the same to be worked and which cannot easily be replaced or made good by attempting to work such apparatus in contravention of this order.

2. The pilot or person for the time being in charge of any aircraft fitted with wireless transmitting apparatus shall secure that any such component part thereof as is specified in the provisions of this order is to be taken away therefrom is kept in safe custody and shall take such steps as are necessary to ensure that the provisions of this order are in all respects complied with.
