the Governor of Uttar Pradesh is pleased to declare that  
pending such enquiry and record the provisions of chap-  
ter IV of the said Act to be applicable to the land  
specified in the schedule hereto;




No person shall, without the permission of a Forest officer, do or attempt to do, or cause to be done any of the following acts:

- (1) The cutting, sawing, conversion and removal of any tree and the collection, manufacture and removal of forest produce from the protected forests,
- (2) The clearing and breaking of land for cultivation of or for making of any threshing floor (khalian) or tethercattle, erecting of any temporary or permanent hut or house in such forests;
- (3) The cutting of grass and pasturing of cattles in such forests, and
- (4) The lighting, kindling or burning of any fire near such forests.
