#### Terms and conditions

### HARYANA STATE

1. The applicants shall maintain good house keeping both within factory and in the premises. All hose pipelines valves, storage tanks etc. shall be leak proof. In plant allowable pollutants levels, if specified by State Board should be met strictly.
2. The applicant/company shall comply with and carry out directive/orders issued by the Board in this consent order at all subsequent times without negligence of his /its part. The applicant/company shall be liable for such legal action against him as per provision of the law/act in case of violation of any order/directives. Issued at any time and or non compliance of the terms and conditions of his consent order.
3. The applicant shall make an application for grant of consent at least 90 days before the date of expiry of this consent.
4. Necessary fee as prescribed for obtaining renewal consent shall be paid by the applicant alongwith the consent application.
5. If due to any technological improvement or otherwise this Board is of opinion that all or any of the conditions referred to above required variation (including the change of any control equipment either in whole or in part) this Board shall after giving the applicant an opportunity of being heard vary all or such condition and there upon the applicant shall be bound to comply with the conditions so varied.
6. The industry shall provide adequate arrangement for fighting the accidental leakages, discharge of any pollutants gas/liquids from the vessels, mechanical equipment etc. which are likely to cause environment pollution.
7. The industry shall comply noise pollution (Regulation and control) Rules, 2000.
8. The industry shall comply all the direction/Rules/Instructions as may be issued by the MOEF/CPCB/HSPCB from time to time.
9. The industry shall ensure that various characteristics of the effluents remain within the tolerance limits as specified in EPA Standard and as amended from time to time and at no time



the concentration of any characteristics should exceed these limits for discharge.

10. The industry would immediately submit the revised application to the Board in the event of any change in the raw material in process, mode of treatment/discharge of effluent. In case of change of process at any stage during the consent period, the industry shall submit fresh consent application alongwith the consent to operate fee, if found due, which may be on any account and that shall be paid by the industry and the industry would immediately submit the consent application to the Board in the event of any change during the year in the raw material, quantity, quality of the effluent, mode of discharge, treatment facilities etc.

11. The officer/official of the Board shall reserve the right to access for the inspection of the industry in connection with the various process and the treatment facilities. The consent to operate is subject to review by the Board at any time.

12. Permissible limits for any pollutants mentioned in the consent to operate order should not exceed the concentration permitted in the effluent by the Board.

13. The industry shall pay the balance fee, in case it is found due from the industry at any time later on.

14. If the industry fails to adhere to any of the conditions of this consent to operate order, the consent to operate so granted shall automatically lapse.

15. If the industry is closed temporarily at its own, they shall inform the Board and obtain permission before restart of the unit.

16. The industry shall comply all the Directions/ Rules/Instructions issued from time to time by the Board.

## MANUFACTURING PROCESS

Raw Cotton in the form of pressed bales is procured from ginner and stored in godowns. From godown it is shifted to Blow Room for cleaning of contaminants and foreign material. Material of Blow room is fed to carding through pipeline with the help of ventilators for further cleaning and individualization of fibers. Output material from card is accumulated inside the cans fitted with castors for transportation. Material from carding is fed to breaker draw frame & then to lap former for combing process. Laps from lap former are fed to comber for further cleaning and removal of short fibers. Material of comber is then fed to Finisher Draw Frame in order to increase uniformity & attenuation of fibers. In case of carded process Breaker Draw Frame Output material is directly fed to finisher Draw Frame bypassing Lap former and Comber. Finisher Draw frame material is now fed to Speed frame. In speed frame, sliver is drawn & twisted to form roving which is wound into bobbins. Such small packages of bobbins from speed Frame are fed to Ring Frame where finally yarn is prepared. This yarn is then run in the Autoconers to make objectionable fault free & convert the yarn into package form on small cones. Yarn in cone form is fed to YCP for twist setting and addition of moisture to yarn which leads to higher strength of yarn. Conditioned yarn cones are then packed in cartons, pallets or HDPE bags and send to the godowns for final dispatch to Customer.

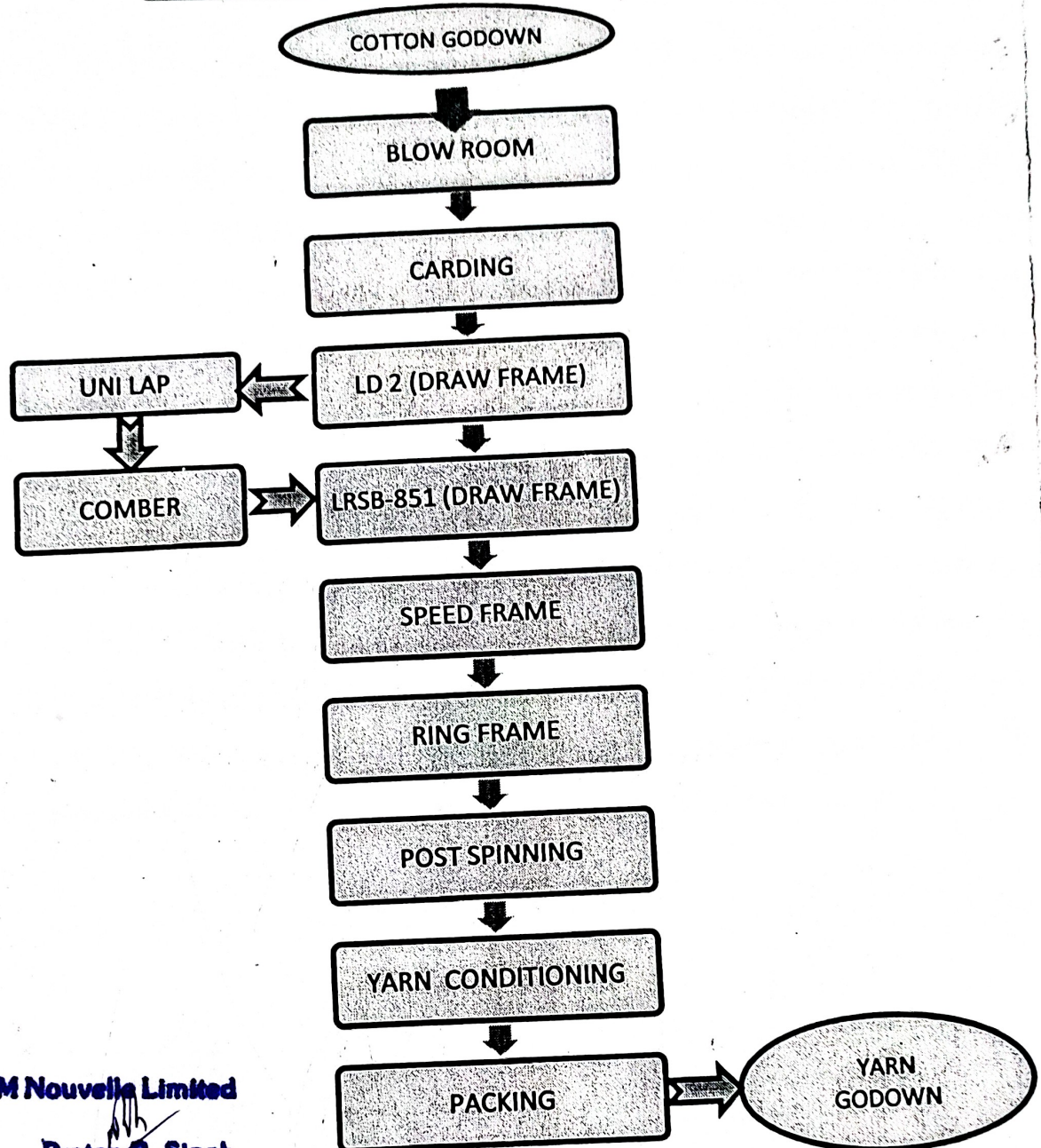
