Protection of natural beauty of the Tourism Sites

Tourism sites often found dirty, filthy, created by the deeds of the tourists most of whom cares a little about the sanctity and purity of the environment and throws the waste and garbage at open places creating pollution throughout the tourist area. Sometimes, carelessness from the end of the authority upon whom the protection of nature lies, creates or allows such types of environmental aberrations. To avoid such nuisance, some measures have been framed that will be taken to preserve the purity of the environment at the Murguma Dam Tourist Project Site.

- i) Utmost care will be taken to protect the site from any type of pollution so that the visitors as well as the wild animals do not feel disturbed.
- ii) There will be community garbage disposal system around the area to protect the area from air or environment pollution.
- iii) Bio-diversity management steps will be taken up there for disposal of bio-degradable waste products.
- iv) Eco- friendly dustbins (vats) will be installed at different corners to avoid vision-pollution.
- v) Bio-toilets will be introduced at the core areas for making the area clean, and, finally,
- vi) SLWM system will be introduced in the site for maintaining the project up to the best.
- vii) Within a very short period, the whole tourism area will be under "No Plastic" usage zone.

Protection of Elephant Corridor:

Utmost care will be taken in case of preservation of the Corridors wherefrom the Elephants often travel in that area. As and when it is received from the end of the Authority concerned, the main route of movements of the Elephants, it will be protected from any type of transport, noise or public movements by constructing iron wire fencing between the animal pathway & Eco-Tourism cottage. It will also serve as preventive measures for the tourists.
