The subject envisages the use of forest land for diversion of 0.456 Ha. of Forest Land {(0.2250 Ha. at Narwana Branch Canal RD 78 - 81 RHS WTP Site Pabra), (0.0945 HA at Bahadurghar to Ghanaur Road from Shekhu pura to Siyalu RHS, Mandauli Cluster), (0.1365 HA at Banur Canal RD Nanhera to Bhuri Majra (RHS))} for the laying of drinking water Pipe line Various Strips in Rajpura Range, Tehsil Rajpura, Distt.
