The proposed land is a forest land which in leased for the widening of

National Highway 4A to NHAI. And it is not a part of National Park,

Sanctuary, Biosphere Reserve, Tiger Reserve, Elephant corridor etc. There

are no archaeologically important monuments and defence sites located in

the proposed land. The legal status of forest land remained as Reserve

Forest and the user agency is ready to pay Compensatory Afforestation

charges, Penal Compensatory afforestation charges, Net Present Value,

lease rent etc. as fixed by the Government. User agency planned for

Underground OFC Cable from Halsi-Londa to Karnataka/Goa Border through

Reserve Forest in various villages of Uttara Karnataka, thus there is no any

damage to Reserve Forest.

It is found that there is no rare/ endangered unique species and

archaeological / heritage site in said Forest area. The requirement of the

forest land as proposed by the user agency is unavoidable and barest

minimum for the project. Since no such trees are found in proposed area.
