In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests (MOEF), Government of India's letter No. 11-9/98-FC (pt.) dated 28th October 2014 it is certified that 0.471 hectares of forest land proposed to be diverted in favor of National Highways Authority of India, (NHAI) for "Development of 6 Lane Access Controlled Greenfield Highway of Shamli - Ambala Sec. from Km Ch. 0+000 to Km Ch. 120+970 (Total length: 120.970 km) in the States of Uttar Pradesh, Haryana & Punjab under Bharatmala Pariyojana Phase II (Lot- 9/Package-I)." (Purpose for diversion of forest land) in Shamli District, the stretch from ch. 0+000 to ch. 14+422 falls in Tehsil Shamli and Unn i.e in the District Shamli.

It is certified that the as per the Gazette Notification no. 4041/XIV dated 15th October 1954, it is notified that forest land proposed to be diverted is plantation which was notified as "Protected Forest" less than 75 years prior to the 13th day of December 2005 and is located in villages having no record population of Schedule Tribes, as per the Census -2001 and Census-2011. The proposal does not involve recognized rights of primitive tribal groups and pre-Agricultural Forest dwelling communities.
