**Subject:** Diversion of 39.5449 ha Forest land for four laning of Tumakuru-Shimoga Section of NH-206, chainage km 12+310 and km 217+000-reg.

With respect to above subject and reference (1) NHAI, PIU (Shimoga) Chitradurga had submitted online proposal for diversion of 39.5449 ha of forest land for improvement of National Highway 206 between Tumkur and Shimoga (Section - I) on 21.12.2017.

Vide reference (2) 8 sets of hard copies of proposal for 1.3762 ha of forest land within Hassan Forest Division were submitted on 29.06.2018. The proposal was verified by RFO of Arasikere. Subsequent to site visit, a letter vide reference (3) on EDS has been received from office of RFO, Arasikere on the shortcomings of the proposal asking NHAI, PIU (Shimoga) Chitradurga to add/delete survey numbers and update the online proposal accordingly.

The proposal is updated as per Essential Data Sought (EDS) received from Office of DCF, Hassan as follows.


