ORDER:

While replying to the debate on demand to Police Department (Demand No.22) on 24.04.2012, the Hon'ble Chief Minister has announced on the floor of the assembly as follows:-

- 2. Based on the above announcement, the Director General of Police has sent a proposal in the letter read above for strengthening of 25 check-posts in the border areas at a total cost of Rs.4,44,70,250/-(Rupees four crores, forty four lakhs, seventy thousand, two hundred and fifty only).
- 3. After careful examination, the Government have decided to strengthen the following 25 inter state border check-posts in the first phase, in order to ensure that the Check-posts function more effectively and achieve better results and record better performance.

- 5. The expenditure is an item of "New Instrument of Service". The approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure will be initially met by sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund. Orders regarding the approval of the Legislature will be issued from Finance (BG.I) Department separately. The Director General of Police is directed to send necessary proposals to Government in Finance (BG.I) Department, in the prescribed format along with a copy of this order for sanction of an advance required for the current year from Contingency Fund.
- 6. The Director General of Police is also directed to send a draft explanatory note, indicating the total cost of the expenditure, the cost that would be required for the implementation during the financial year etc. to Government in

Finance (BG.I) Department for inclusion of the expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for bringing it to the notice of the Legislature in due course.

7. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O.No. 58814/Home.l/2012, dated 26.10.2012 with Additional, Sanction Ledger No.1419(One thousand four hundred and nineteen).
