Dharmapuram is a remote village where the people are suffering a lot for travelling to the mandal head quarters and there on to district head quarters for their medical aid, education, transportation of agricultural produce etc., It is proposed to improve from gravel road to Bituminous road. The Telangana State Government have taken a policy decision to improve the interior roads to R&B standards. There is no other alternative except proposing upgradation in forest area of Kothagudem Division. Hence, this existing gravel road having the sufficient width of 10.00 mts, there is no need for extra widening and there no need of felling trees for widening.
