Dear Sir,

GAIL (India) Limited has been authorized by GoI to lay 254 KM x 18" Dhamra-Haldia Natural Gas Pipeline vide PNGRB authorization dated Infra/NGPL/124/GAIL/JHBDPL/01/19 dated 08.11.2019. Detailed route survey was carried out for this project and accordingly a forest diversion proposal for diversion of 1.611 Ha of forestland was submitted to forest department vide proposal No. FP/OR/Pipeline/148595/2021.

The forest area proposed for diversion under this proposal was revised and increased to 1.849 Ha of forestland as few forest plots which are currently of non-forest nature but as per sabik details are forest were inadvertently missed at the initial stage during the preparation of the forest diversion proposal.

GAIL had informed to the forest department regarding increase of forest land and same was updated in the forest proposal (revised proposal dated 16.11.2022) as soon as it came to our notice. However, the pipeline was already laid in the said sabik forest lands falling under Baripada Forest Division prior to submission of the proposal as the Hal Kisam of these lands are non-forest/private.

Sir, this violation on sabik forest has been unintentional and by mistake of our project team prior to submission of the proposal. Since the act of violation was unintentional and the sabik forest land involved in this violation is very small (0.2379 Ha) and also the Hal Kisam of these lands are non-forest/private, this act of violation may please be condoned in the interest of this Govt. of India project of national importance.
