Kindly refer to your office letter No. PW/BD/CB/WA-II/Forest/2022/9277-78 dated 23-08-2022 on the subject cited above.

In this connection, it is submitted that proposed site for construction of Tata Pani to Khun Sulhanu Dhar Road 0/00 to 9/400 in Distt. Kullu does not fall within the boundary of Great Himalayan National Park as well as its proposed Eco Sensitive Zones. The Aerial distance from Great Himalayan National Park & its proposed Eco Sensitive Zone is as under:-
