3.00 The proposal has been initiated by the Executive Engineer, National Highway Division, Amravati, Bandhkam Bhavan, PWD Premises, Camp Road, Amravati-444602 for seeking approval under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. The existing road has very poor geometry, congestion leading to traffic jams. Therefore the User Agency has decided to undertake improvement of National Highway section NH-161 A (Poharadevi Link). The total length as per assignment 40.00 km+ 5.132 km between Chainage 0+00 Km. to Chainage 40+00 km and Chainage 0+000 km to Chainage 5+132 km in the District of Washim. Because of the project, over all road safety situation will be improved. There will be decrease in road traffic accidents immediately after implementation of the project. Summarily, widening of the project road will have following benefits.

- a) The proposed project is rehabilitation and up-gradation of existing two lane alignment to four lane configuration.
- b) There is no suitable alternatives non-forest land to construct the road as the proposed rehabilitation is along the existing road.
- c) Earthwork cutting and banking is minimum.
- d) Minimum numbers of trees are affected.
- e) Road gradients are suitable for traffic.

Total non forest involved in the project is 2.086 ha. The site inspection report of the Deputy Conservator of Forests, Washim Forest Divisions are enclosed on page no. 40 to 42.

- 4.9 and proposed Compensatory Afforestation over 11.50 ha. degraded Forest land in Compartment No.C-148, at village-Bhildongar, Tehsil-Manora, District-Washim it is contiguous, suitable for afforestaion and management purpose and it is free from encroachment and an encumbrances.
- 5.00 The User Agency has submitted an undertaking that:-
- 5.1 to defray the cost of compensatory afforestation.  $\sqrt{27}$
- 5.2 to defray the cost of Net Present Value of the forest land proposed under diversion. P
- 5.3 Government of India vide letter No.11-43/2013-FC, dt.3/12/2018 has issued guidelines regarding compliance of the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forests Right) Act, 2006. As per these guidelines:-

'Accordingly, it is clarified that within the time period stipulated for compliance of Stage I condition, Deputy Commissioner shall complete the process of compliance of FRA (including forwarding its findings to be concerned CF), hence for the purpose of the MoEF & CC, as per the provisions under the Forest (Conservation) amendment rules, 2016 the compliance under FRA is not required for consideration of in-principle approval. This has to be furnished by the State Government for consideration of the proposal by the Ministry for final approval'.

Hence, the user agency has given an undertaking regarding the compliance under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 has been applied and is under process and shall be submitted before in-principle approval.

- 6.00 The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Washim Forest Division, Washim and Chief Conservator of Forest (T), Yavatmal have recommended the proposal for diversion of 5.610 ha. of forest land.

- 7.00 In view of this, the proposal is recommended for approval under the section -2 (ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 subject to the following conditions: –
- 7.1 The legal status of the forest land required will remain unchanged.
- 7.2 Forest land will be handed over only after required non-forest land for the project is handed over to the User Agency.

#### 7.3 Compensatory Afforestaton:-

- a) Compensatory afforstation shall be taken up by the Forest Department over 11.50 ha. degraded Forest land in Compartment No.C-148, at village-Bhildongar, Tehsil-Manora, District-Washim at the cost of the user agency. As far as possible, a mixture of local indigenous species shall be planted and monoculture of any species may be avoided.
- 7.4 The cost of compensatory afforestation at the prevailing wage rates as per compensatory afforestation scheme and the cost of survey, demarcation and erection of permanent pillars if required on the CA land shall be deposited in advance with the Forest Department by the project authority. The CA will be maintained for 10 years. The scheme may include appropriate provision for anticipated cost increase for works scheduled for subsequent years.

#### 7.5 NPV:-

- a) The State Government shall charge the Net Present Value (NPV) for the 5.610 ha. forest area to be diverted under this proposal from the User Agency as per the orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 30/10/2002, 01/08/2003, 28/03/2008, 24/04/2008 and 09/05/2008 in IA No.566 in WP (C) No.202/1995 and as per the guidelines issued by the Ministry vide letters No.5-1/1998-FC (Pt.II), dated 18/09/2003 as well as letter No.5-2/2006-FC, dated 03/10/2006 and 5-3/2007-FC, dated 05/02/2009 in this regard.
- b) Additional amount of the NPV of the diverted forest land, if any, becoming due after finalization of the same by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India on receipt of the report from the Expert Committee, shall be charged by the State Government from the User Agency. The User Agency shall furnish an undertaking to this effect.
- 7.6 User Agency shall restrict the felling of trees to minimum number in the diverted forest land and the trees shall be felled under the strict supervision of the State Forest Department and the cost of felling of trees shall be deposited by the User Agency with the State Forest Department.
- 7.7 All the funds received from the user agency under the project shall be transferred/deposited to CAMPA fund only through e-portal (<a href="http://parivesh.nic.in/">http://parivesh.nic.in/</a>)
   7.8 The complete compliance of the EPA 2006 http://parivesh.nic.in/
- 7.8 The complete compliance of the FRA, 2006 shall be ensured by way of prescribed certificate from the concerned District Collector before Stage-II approval.
- 7.9 User Agency shall raise strip plantation on both sides and central verge of the road as per the IRC norms.



- 7.10 Speed regulating signage will be erected along the road at regular intervals in the Protected Areas/Forest Areas.
- 7.11 The user agency shall provide suitable under/over pass in Protected Area/ Forest Area as per recommendation of CWLW/NBWL/FAC/REC.
- 7.12 The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government.
- 7.13 No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.
- 7.14 Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the User Agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or the Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel.
- 7.15 The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost, as per the directions of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer.
- 7.16 No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.
- 7.17 The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal.
- 7.18 It Shall mandatory to provide underpass for safe crossing of wild animals:-
  - (a) The underpass shall have a minimum size of width 4.00 mt and Height 3.00 mt.
  - (b) Wherever natural cross drainage works are in existence, then no need to construct new underpass subject to existing structure nearly complying above mentioned dimensions, as suggested in (a) above.
  - (c) Wherever natural cross drainage works are in existence but as per engineering requirement, it is required to reconstruct then that structure shall comply with the minimum dimensions as suggested in (a) above.
  - (d) Interval between such underpasses shall not be more than 2.00 km
- 7.19 The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without prior approval of Government of India.
- 7.20 Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as per the MoEF&CC Guidelines F.No.11-42/2017-FC, dated 29/01/2018.
- 7.21 Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife.

- 7.8 The complete compliance of the FRA, 2006 shall be ensured by way of prescribed certificate from the concerned District Collector before Stage-II approval.
- 7.9 User Agency shall raise strip plantation on both sides and central verge of the road as per the IRC norms.
- 7.10 Speed regulating signage will be erected along the road at regular intervals in the Protected Areas/Forest Areas.
- 7.11 The user agency shall provide suitable under/over pass in Protected Area/ Forest Area as per recommendation of CWLW/NBWL/FAC/REC.
- 7.12 The layout plan of the proposal shall not be changed without prior approval of Central Government.
- 7.13 No labour camp shall be established on the forest land.
- 7.14 Sufficient firewood, preferably the alternate fuel, shall be provided by the User Agency to the labourer after purchasing the same from the State Forest Department or the Forest Development Corporation or any other legal source of alternate fuel.
- 7.15 The boundary of the diverted forest land shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost, as per the directions of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer.
- 7.16 No additional or new path will be constructed inside the forest area for transportation of construction materials for execution of the project work.
- 7.17 The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal.
- 7.18 It Shall mandatory to provide underpass for safe crossing of wild animals:-
  - (a) The underpass shall have a minimum size of width 4.00 mt and Height 3.00 mt.
  - (b) Wherever natural cross drainage works are in existence, then no need to construct new underpass subject to existing structure nearly complying above mentioned dimensions, as suggested in (a) above.
  - (c) Wherever natural cross drainage works are in existence but as per engineering requirement, it is required to reconstruct then that structure shall comply with the minimum dimensions as suggested in (a) above.

(d) Interval between such underpasses shall not be more than 2.00 km

7.19 The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies, department or person without prior approval of Government of India.

Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as per the MoEF&CC Guidelines F.No.11-42/2017-FC, dated 29/01/2018.

7.21 Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife.
