

**FIELD INSPECTION NOTE OF THE FOREST DIVISIONAL OFFICER, KAGHAZNAGAR IN
SIRPUR RANGE OF KAGHAZNAGAR DIVISION**

Today on 06.10.2020 inspected the proposed Diversion of Forest Land to an extent of **0.4000 Ha** of forest land for improvement of existing road and widening from R/F PWD to Kanki (Yedlagudem) in favour of District Panchayat Raj Engineer, Kumrambheem Asifabad District along with concerned staff. As per the field verification, the proposed area is passing through the following Reserve Forest, the details are as follows.

The aforesaid proposed diversion area is passing through Muthampet RF in Sirpur Range. The total length is **800 meters** with a width of **5 meters** which is amounting to the total area, required for diversion in Kaghaznagar division is **0.400 Ha**.



In the proposed diversion area, no unique tree is found, no protected archaeological / heritage site / defense establishment or any other important monument is found in the area. **The proposed diversion area doesn't form part of National parks, Wildlife Sanctuaries, Biosphere Reserve & Elephant corridor etc.** There is no tree growth existing on the proposed diversion area.

The area proposed for diversion is bare minimum and unavoidable without alternatives for the project. No violation against the Forest Conservation Act, 1980 has been carried out by the User Agency. Hence it is recommended for considering the proposal.
