Site Inspection report of the Deputy Conservator of Forests, Kudremukh Wildlife Division, Karkala for the proposal of Gravity drinking water supply pipeline from kithlemanekodige, Hulugarubailu to kigga in Shringeri Tq. Chikmagalur district


A Forest and wildlife clearance proposal [FP/KA/WATER/35135/2018] made by the User Agency – EE, KRIDLChikmagalur on the web portal www.parivesh.nic.in has been received by this office on the web portal. The project envisages the **Gravity drinking water supply pipeline from kithlemanekodige, Hulugarubailu to kigga in Shringeri Tq. Chikmagalur district**. The site inspection of the said area has been done by me on dated 24th November 2020

User agency proposed for Diversion of 0.05404 ha (540.4 sq. mtrs) of land for Gravity drinking water supply pipeline to kithlemanekodige, Hulugarubailu to kigga passing through Kigga RF & Narasimha Parvatha RF for a distance of 1201 mtrs X 0.45 mtrs. The proposed area is passing through Sy. No: 49 & 55 of length 255 mtrs and 582 mtrs respectively in Markal Village and in Sy. No. 146 of length 364 mtrs in Yadehalli village, Kigga hobli, Sringeri taluk, Chikmagalur District falls in Kigga Reserve Forest & Narasimha Parvatha Reserve Forest of Kudremukh National Park.

The proposed project is for laying of pipeline along the stream & the area proposed is barest minimum. There is no perceivable impact on forest, wildlife habitat & environment as it doesn't involve any tree felling or habitat fragmentation.

No part/work of the proposed project has started without proper sanction. Providing for basic facilities like water supply pipeline for public in this area will help the department to gain confidence and cooperation of villagers by conservation efforts.
