Site inspection

The New Nawada - New Gaya - Khizisarai 220 KV D/C (HTLS) transmission line site was inspected by the undersigned on 02.09.2016. The transmission line falls in mauza Khanwa, Thana and Block - Narhat, District - Nawada. The proposed are in along Hisua - Narhat -Sirdala Road which is declared as notified Protected Forest Vide Notification No. 189 (E), Dated 16/02/1994. The salient features of the site inspection report are as follows.

- The length of the Protected Forest falling was measured. Area proposed for diversion is 35m x 6m from edge of road on both sides (flanker on both sides). Thus total area i. diverted for this purpose is 0.042 Ha. Calculation is shown in the map attached.
- The area proposed for diversion is barest minimum and unavoidable. No alternative ii. route is feasible for the said diversion.
- The site is not prone to soil erosion. iii.
- The site does not form part of a National Park, Wild life Sanctuary, Biosphere Reserve, Tiger Reserve and Elephant Corridor etc. The nearest wild life sanctuary is vi. Rajgir Wildlife Sanctuary, Bihar Sharif, whose distance from work site is about 15 Km radius.
- No rare/ endangered/ unique species of flora or fauna are reported from this area. V.
- No protected archeological / heritage / defense establishment or any other important vii. monument was seen during the site inspection.
- No tree is to be felled during construction of this transmission line. viii.
