Sub : Diversion of 25.402 Ha. of Forest land for in favor of NHAI for Construction of 4 Lanning Saha to Shahabad Section form Km 14.840 to 30.300 under Forest Division and Distt. Ambala, Haryana .

A detailed inspection of the Project Site was carried out by the undersigned on 30-09-2020, along D.F.O. Ambala concerned field staff of Ambala Forest Division. During this inspection following observations were made during the course of inspection:-

- (1) During the inspection, it was found that a **Diversion of 25.402 Ha. of Forest land for in favor of NHAI for Construction of 4 Lanning Saha to Shahabad Section form Km 14.840 to 30.300 under Forest Division and Distt. Ambala, Haryana.** This diversion of Forest Land is unavoidable and is the barest minimum possible. There is no alternative suitable non forest land available for the project.
- (2) In the proposal, a total of **12137 (Vol. 10618.49) trees required to be felled** for the project.
- (3) The total volume of trees which are to be felled for the execution of this Project is **10618.49 Cubic meter.** The marking of trees proposed for felling has been done as per the project site plan. It is hereby made very clear that 12137 No. of trees are necessarily required to be felled for the project. The project site is surrounded by adjoining agricultural land and is similar to the land plan submitted by the user agency. Moreover, there are no rare/endangered species of Flora and Fauna in this area. The main species is Eucalyptus.
- (4) The user agency has not violated the provisions of Forest Conservation Act, 1980 and also they have not done any work on the site so far.

Based on the detailed site inspection carried out by the undersigned on 30-09-2020, it is hereby recommended that the proposal may be considered in the large public interest.



A detailed inspection of the Project Site was carried out by the undersigned on 25-09-2020, along D.F.O. Kurukshetra concerned field staff of Kurukshetra Forest Division. During this inspection following observations were made during the course of inspection:-

- (1) During the inspection, it was found that a Diversion of 27.792 ha. (2.39 ha. In Kurukshetra) of Forest land Construction of 4-lanning of Saha to Shahbad, Section from Km 14.840 to Km 31.760 of NH-444(A) in the State of Haryana under foreset división & Distt. Kurukshetra This diversion of Forest Land is unavoidable and is the barest minimum possible. There is no alternative suitable non forest land available for the project.
- (2) In the proposal, a total of 976 (Vol. 2137.15) trees required to be felled no saplings will be destroyed for the project.
- (3) The total volume of trees which are to be felled for the execution of this Project is 2137.15 Cubic meter. The marking of trees proposed for felling has been done as per the project site plan. It is hereby made very clear that 976 No. of trees are necessarily required to be felled for the project. The project site is surrounded by adjoining agricultural land and is similar to the land plan submitted by the user agency. Moreover, there are no rare/endangered species of Flora and Fauna in this area. The main species is Eucalyptus.
- (4) The user agency has not violated the provisions of Forest Conservation Act, 1980 and also they have not done any work on the site so far.

Based on the detailed site inspection carried out by the undersigned on 25-09-2020, it is hereby recommended that the proposal may be considered in the large public interest.
