

RECOMMENDATIONS WITH JUSTIFICATIONS

The proposed forest area is already diverted under erstwhile Jammu and Kashmir, Forest (Conservation) Act, 1997 vide Government Order No. **376-FST of 2019 Dated:-25-10-2019** titled “**Use of 15.0318 Ha of forest land coming under the re-alignment of 132 KV D/C Chenani Srinagar Transmission Line between Ramban to Banihal in Ramban Division by PDD**” and due to oversighting on part of the User Agency and Field staff, the trees were not included in the enumeration list at that time. Only the felling permission of 46 tree is required. The patch of tree falls within already diverted corridor (27m) near tower SR-3 for 132 KV transmission line between towers SR-3 to SR-4. The User Agency is same and propose of the diverted forest land has not changed. The Compensatory Afforestation has already been charged for **Rs 30.06 lacs** in the Government order **376-FST of 2019 Dated:-25-10-2019**. NPV amounting **Rs 1.2428 crores** has already been charged in the Govt order mentioned above.
