## Dear Sir,

This is in reference to your request for getting our NOC as required by MoEF in relation to forest land diversion proposal and as communicated to you through MoEF letter dated Oct 14, 2020 (File No. 8-04/2020-FC) (letter attached). In that letter, it was communicated that Six (06) power transmission lines including our 765 kV S/C Jabalpur-Bina line is passing through the project area and hence 'NOC' from these Transmission Companies (Licensees) needs to be submitted in relation to forest land diversion proposal.

Further as discussed in meeting held on Nov 03, 2020 between WRD Sagar Officials, its Consultant TATA projects, Jabalpur Transmission Co. Ltd (JTCL) -The Transmission Licensee & Sterlite Power (Project Manager), following are the terms and conditions that were discussed and was accepted by WRD. The same needs to be accepted and signed by Competent/ Authorised WRD, Sagar, Official, before we issue the required NOC for the said subject:

- 1. Approvals WRD, Sagar shall be responsible for obtaining all the statutory clearances & regulatory approvals, not limited to CEA / WRPC / WRLDC / MoEF/ Environment and Forest Clearances/ Wild Life/ National Parks/ Wild Life Sanctuaries/Civil and Military Air fields/ Civil Aviation/ PTCC/ Road/ River/ Indian Railways /Canals/Power Line Crossing/ State Govt Approvals/ Local authorities approval or any approvals required for shifting of our existing 765 kV S/C Jabalpur-Bina line on behalf of Jabalpur Transmission Company Limited, which is an interstate transmission line, providing stability to our national Grid from concerned authorities/agencies.
- 2. Right Of Way (ROW): Right of way and way leave clearance shall be arranged by WRD, Sagar in accordance with the requirements of construction. Compensation for right of way & way leaves shall be given as per applicable law, rules & regulations, guidelines, and directives of local administrative and revenue authorities. Any incidental and commercial matter including litigation with respect to the above proposed modification of line including ROW shall be the responsibility of WRD, Sagar. Once all necessary clearances and approvals are obtained by WRD By releasing the requisite charges at their end, the works on ground will be allowed.
- 3. Cost The dismantling and rerouting of the affected towers of 765 kV S/C Jabalpur-Bina line will be done on a cost-plus basis and all costs including but not limited to survey, design, testing, dismantling, erection, foundation, stringing, ROW cost, revenue & incentive loss, supervision charges & other relevant overheads etc will be borne by WRD Sagar based on the estimate prepared by JTCL. All payments in this regard shall be made in advance.



- 4. Revenue Loss: Due to shifting/modification of the above lines due to WRD, Sagar request, JTCL shall be incurring shut down/ disruption which will lead to revenue loss of our legitimate transmission charges, Hence WRD, Sagar, shall compensate in advance before start of work the revenue loss calculated by JTCL. All payments in this regard shall be made in advance by WRD, Sagar.
- 5. Execution work As per Section 40 of the Electricity Act-2003, it is 's duty "to build, maintain and operate an efficient, co-ordinated and economical" transmission system for the term of the Transmission Licensee i.e. 35 years. Further, as per CEA norms "the overall responsibility of such modification works will lie with M/s JTCL only. Hence, the execution work for rerouting of the line will be carried out by JTCL only, considering that the asset will be operational for 35 years and our revenues are linked to the operation of the line in an economical and efficient manner.
- Duration of Work: The estimated duration of outage of the proposed modification shall be based on assessment made by JTCL and further subject to WRLDC approval and may require multiple line outage.
- 7. **Taxes and duties**: All incidental taxes and duties, with respect to above proposed works, shall be payable at applicable Government rates by WRD
- 8. Delays beyond control of JTCL, resulting in any additional cost shall be compensated by WRD based on the claim(s) shared by JTCL.
- 9. The above works are subject to the outcome of the survey being carried out by JTCL, for which WRD, Sagar has already made the payments.

Please note that we shall issue the required NOC for getting the forest approval, only once these terms and conditions are accepted in writing by WRD Sagar

We understand and appreciate the above project being a state project and being carried out by WRD, Sagar and would surely like to contribute in this in a proactive manner.
