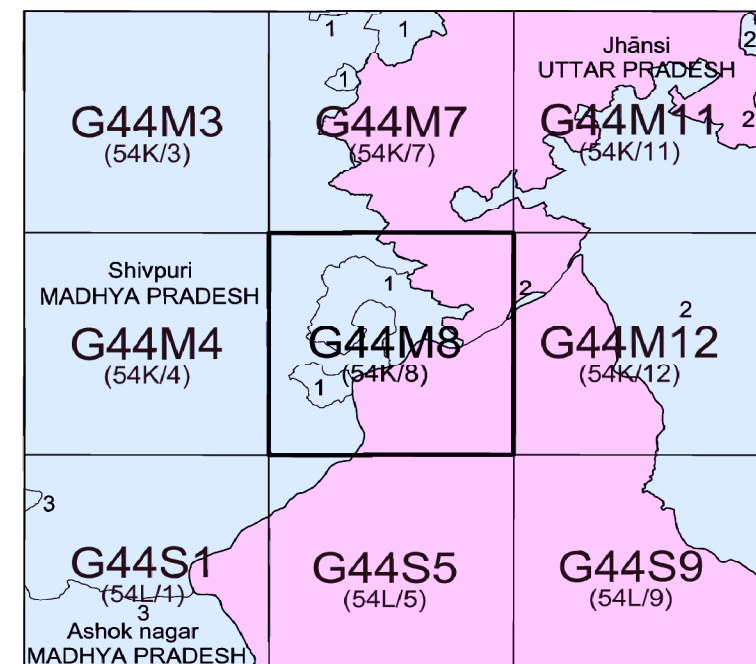

Perennial streams in this sheet are generally fordable from November to June.

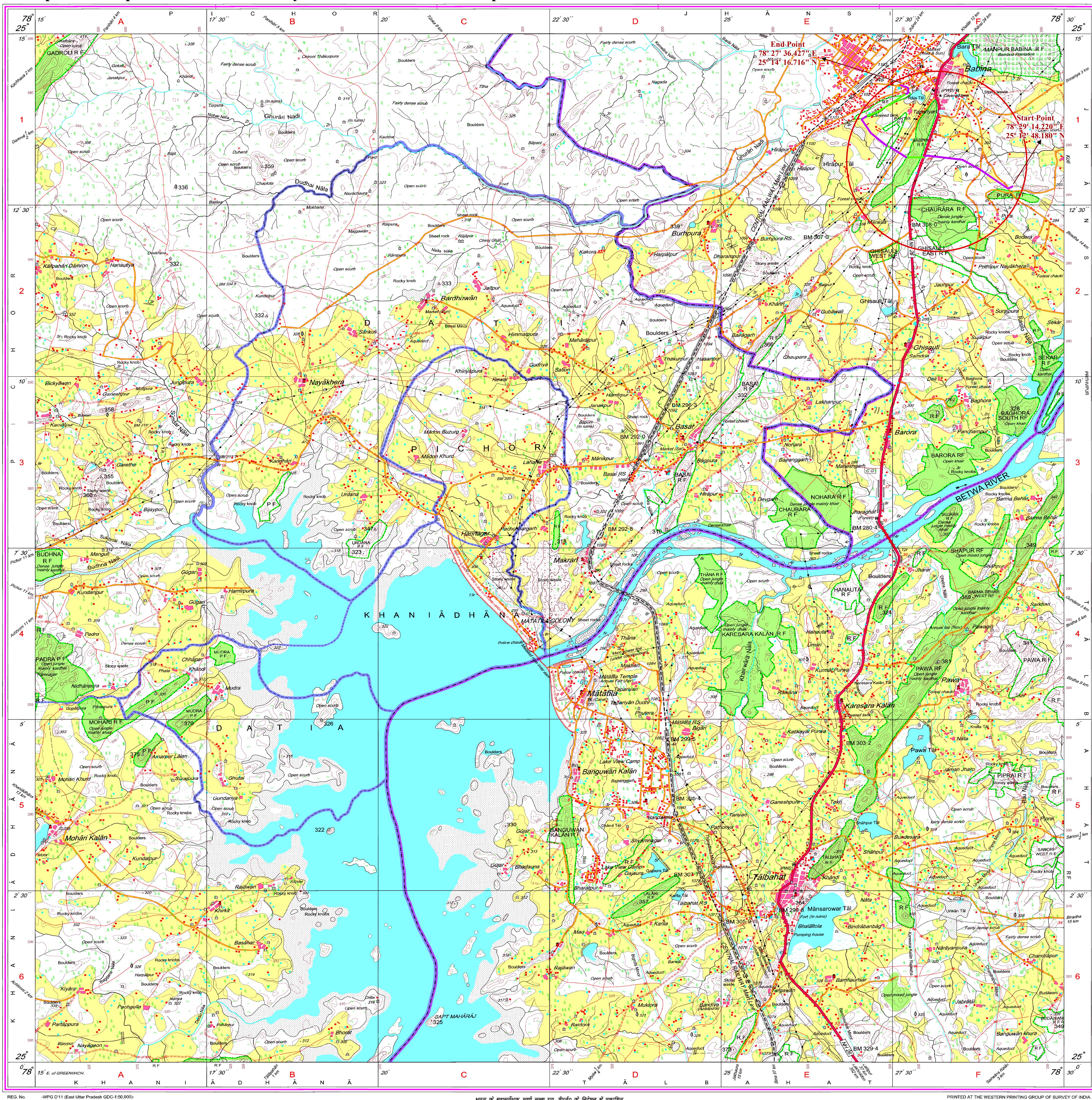
