In Compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forest (MoEF), Government of India's letter no.11-9/98-FC (pt) 3/8/2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 ('FRA', for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes, it is certified that 0.0016 ha of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Central Water Commission, Gangtok (name of user agency) for diversion 0.0016 ha of Forest land for installation of Automatic Data acquisition & Real Time Data Transmission System through Satellite for Snow Gauges and Rainfall Measurement at Sherathang in East District, Government of Sikkim.(purpose for diversion of forest land) in East district falls within jurisdiction of Sherathang (s) in Kyongnosla tehsils.

It is further certified that:-

- The diversion of such division (with full details of the project and its implications, in vernacular/local language have been placed before each concerned Gram Sabha of Forest Dwellers, who are eligible under the FRA;
- d. The discussion and decisions on such proposals had taken place only when there was a quorum of minimum 50% of the members of Gram Sabha present.
- e. The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3 (2) of the FRA have been completed and the Gram Sabhas have given their consents to it.
- f. The rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities, where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per section 3 (1) (e) of the FRA...
