

**JOINT CERTIFICATE FOR NON-AVAILABILITY OF NON-FOREST LAND FOR COMPENSATORY  
AFFORESTATION**

This is to certify that non-forest lands are not available under the Territorial jurisdiction of East District/Forest Division for Compensatory Afforestation to be raised in lieu of Forest land to be diverted for the non-forestry purposes of User Agency, mentioned below:-

- (a). Name of Proposal with location: - **Diversion of 0.442ha of Forest land for construction of connectivity road from Amrit Turning to Mamjey in East District of Sikkim.**
- (b). Name of User Agency: - **Rural Management and Development Department,  
Government of Sikkim.**
- (c). Area of Forest land to be diverted: - **0.442ha.**

The geographical area of East District of Sikkim is 95400 hectares while the Forest land has been recorded to the extent of 61952 hectares only, which is found to be more than 50% of the geographical area of the district as per the FSI Report 67900 ha.

The Joint Certificate is granted as per the Rules & Guidelines Para 3.2 (v) of Forest (Conservation) Rules 2003 – Guidelines & Clarification and recent Guidelines received from the Ministry of Environment and Forests, Government of India in connection with the diversion of Non Forest land for non-forestry purposes under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980-Non availability of Non Forest land for creation of Compensatory Afforestation vide letter no.11-423/2011-FC dated the 13<sup>th</sup> February 2012.
