**Compensation** against land and structures have been paid (> 80%) to the affected families who have submitted the requisite documents in villages Banbaspur, Solada, Telipur, Khuringa, GopalprasadKhamar. If the documents are not received from the land oustees, balance amount will be deposited in CBA Tribunal Talcher as per provisions of the CBA (A&D) Act, 1957.

### Rehabilitation

Employment benefits are being provided to the eligible displaced families who conform to Cat-I and Cat-II land oustees as per R&R Policy 2006 of Govt of Odisha.

Onetime cash compensation in lieu of employment benefits is also being provided to the families who are eligible for employment benefits as Cat-I and Cat-II land oustees as per R&R Policy 2006 of Govt of Odisha, if they submit such option. The current rate of onetime cash compensation in lieu of employment benefits per eligible family is Rs 16,00,000/-

Annuity in lieu of employment is being provided to the families who are eligible for employment benefits as Cat-I and Cat-II land oustees as per R&R Policy 2006 of Govt of Odisha, if they submit such option. The current rate of annuity in lieu of employment benefits per eligible family is Rs 21,000 per month with a biennial increment of Rs 1000.

## Resettlement

*Plot at resettlement site at Jamunali.*


Govt Land measuring 57.69 Ac in village Jamunali has been leased out to Hingula Area for resettlement of Project Displaced Families (PDFs) of village Kalamchhuin. As per the approved plan of Talcher Angul Meramandali Development Authority (TAMDA), the resettlement site consists of 595 plots, each measuring 0.06 Ac to be allotted to eligible PDFs for resettlement. Other infrastructural facilities planned at the site includes:


1. Educational UGME School

17. RCC Overhead tank.


Apart from the PDFs of village Kalamchhuin, some PDFs of the villages affected by Balaram 15 MTY expansion project are also envisaged to be resettled at the R&R site at Jamunali. However, in view of the limited number of plots at the R&R site and in light of the fact that the State Govt has expressed its inability to allot Govt land for resettlement for each village, MCL is persuading the eligible PDFs to accept onetime cash compensation in lieu of resettlement plot and self-relocate to a place of their choice.

*Onetime Cash compensation in lieu of resettlement plot.*

The PDFs who are eligible for resettlement benefits can also opt for taking Onetime Cash compensation in lieu of resettlement plot and self-relocate to a place of their choice. The details of onetime Cash compensation in lieu of resettlement plot, being offered presently by MCL is as follows:

**ORISSA RESETTLEMENT AND REHABILITATION POLICY, 2006**

In order to ensure sustained development through a participatory and transparent process, Government have framed a comprehensive Resettlement and Rehabilitation Policy. Basic objectives of the policy are :-

1. to avoid displacement wherever possible and minimize it exercising available options otherwise;
2. to recognize voices of displaced communities emphasizing the needs of the indigenous communities and vulnerable sections;
3. to ensure environmental sustainability through participatory and transparent process; and
4. to help guiding the process of developing institutional mechanism for implementation, monitoring, conflict resolution and grievance redressal.

With the above objectives in view, Government has been pleased to lay down the following policy guidelines.

**Orissa Resettlement and Rehabilitation Policy, 2006**

**Preamble :**

Government of Orissa has been pursuing various development initiatives to improve the quality of lives. Ensuring social justice being one of the major cornerstones of development, the Government always proactively tries to make sure people's participation in development process. In spite of Government's intention to bring development to the people, development interventions do at times create undesirable consequences. Displacement due to large development projects is one such phenomenon. Government of Orissa has been responding to this problem through various projects specific Resettlement & Rehabilitation Policies and Plans. The current intervention of Policy formulation has actually taken note of the lessons learnt through these past policies, which essentially reflects Government's genuine spirit of learning and retrospection. The present Policy draws its strength from experiences from the implementation of past policies, best practices in other states and Orissa Government's Industrial Policy Resolution, 2001. Consultation with various direct and indirect stakeholders including civil society of the state has been conducted and the views of the academicians, and specialists in the field of resettlement and rehabilitation have been considered as a part of democratic response of the Government in Policy formulation. Limitations of the past policies have been acknowledged and analyzed and a flexible frame work has been attempted, which nonetheless demonstrates the dynamism of the Government. Unlike many other policies, there is a strong focus on the modalities of implementation of this Policy that makes it a vibrant instrument to promote sustainable development in the state.

**CIRCULAR**

The Board of Directors of MCL in their 181<sup>st</sup> meeting held on 17.09.2016 have kindly approved the proposal for enhancing the amount of one time cash compensation in lieu of employment and resettlement plot as mentioned below to be paid to eligible families as per provision of R&R Policies of Govt. of Odisha.



The above Revised Rates for one time cash compensation in lieu of employment and One time cash compensation in lieu of resettlement plot will be made effective from 1<sup>st</sup> November 2016.

The cases of cash compensation in lieu of employment and One time cash compensation in lieu of resettlement plot approved by the "MCL Board's Sub-Committee of FDs for land oustee cases" / competent authority on or after 1<sup>st</sup> November 2016 only will be covered under Revised Rates. Old cases which are approved before 01-11-2016 will not be eligible for Revised Rates.

Disputed cases, if any, will be dealt as per individual merit of the cases by MCL Board's Sub-Committee of FDs for land oustee cases.

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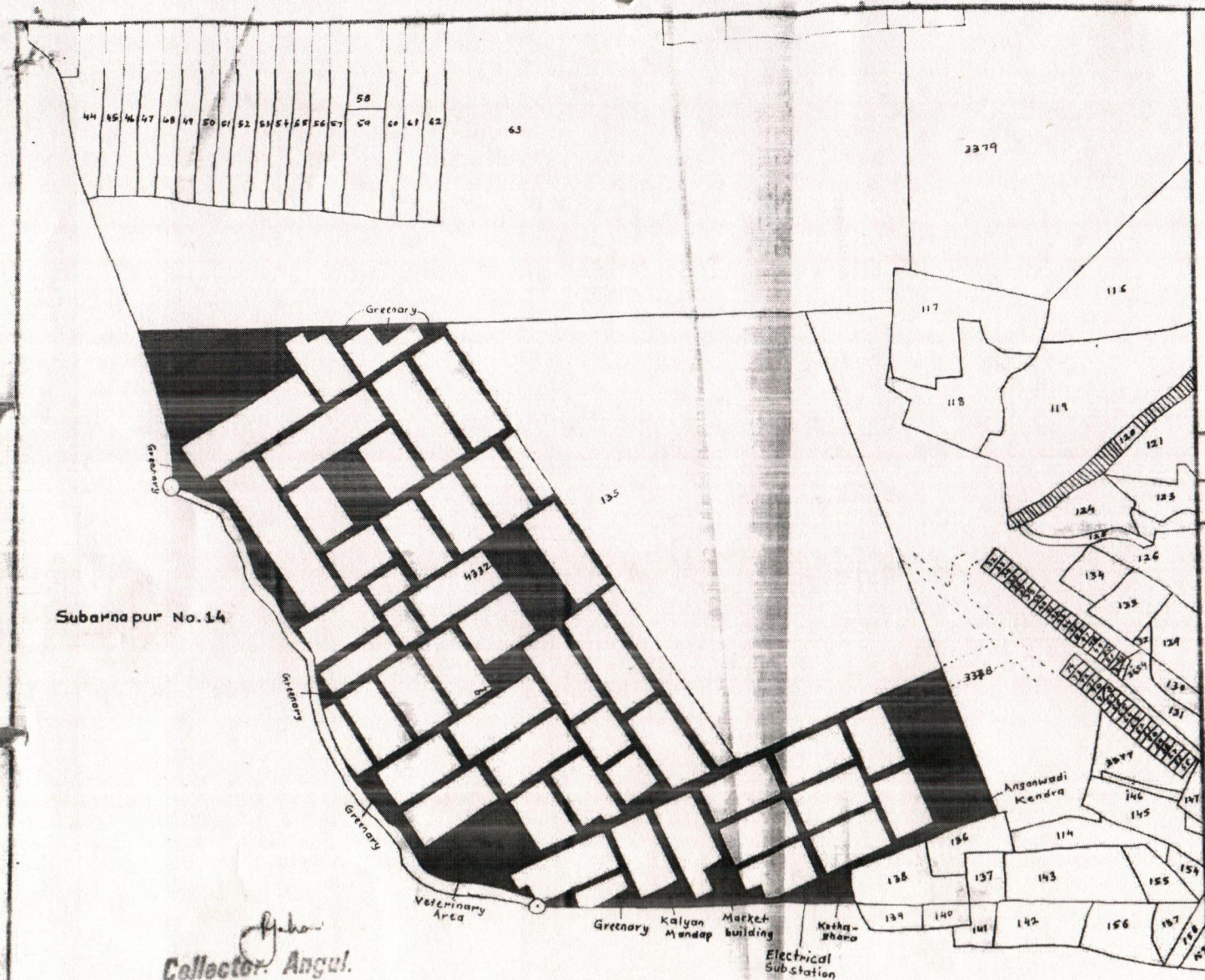
