
TO WHOM SO EVER IT MAY CONCERN

In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forests(MoEF), Government of India's letter No.11-9/98-FC (pt.) dated 3<sup>rd</sup> August 2009 where in the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Right Act, 2006) (FRA, for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purpose, it is certified that 209.807 hectare of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Irrigation Department Government Of Uttar Pradesh (name of user agency) for Constructions Of Bhaunrat Dam (purpose for diversion of forest land) in Lalitpur district falls within jurisdiction of Bhaunrat, Chhaparat, Sakroni, Gaganiva, & Digwar village(s) in Mehroni Tehsils.

It is further certified that:

- a) The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 209.807 hectares of forest area proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultations and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee (s), Gram Sabha(s), Sub-Division Level Committee(s) and the District Level Committee are enclosed as annexure One to 12 annexure.
- b) The proposal for such diversion (with full details of the project and its implications, in vernacular/ local language ) have placed before each concerned gram Sabha of Forest-dwellers, who eligible under the FRA.
- c) The each of concerned Gram Sabha(s), has certified that all formalities/ processes under the FRA have been carried out, and that they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensation and ameliorative measures, if any, having understood the purpose and details of proposed diversion. A copy of certificate issused by the gram sabha of Bhaunrat, Chhaparat, Sakroni, Gaganiva, & Digwar Mehroni Tehsil villages is enclosed as annexure.
- d) The discussion and decisions on such proposals had taken pace only when there was a quorum of minimun 50% of the members of Gram Sabha present.
- e) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3 (2) of the FRA have been completed and the Gram Sabhas have given their consent to it.
- f) The rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre-Agricultural Communities, where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per section 3 (1) (e) of the FRA.
